ANZ Gold – now with Sphere

ANZ today announced a range of new features for the ANZ Gold Visa card, including the option of its innovative chip-based credit card rewards program, Sphere.

Launched in July 2002 for the ANZ First Visa card, Sphere is Australia's first integrated chip-based loyalty program offering participating ANZ Gold card customers the benefits of points-based rewards as well as attainable Instant Rewards at chip-enabled retailers.

Features of the Sphere reward program include:

- Instant Rewards consisting of exclusive in-store discounts on purchases

ANZ Managing Director for Credit Cards Australia Ms Jenny Fagg said Sphere had been added to the range of options for ANZ Gold because cardholders wanted a loyalty program to accompany the standard benefits of their Gold credit card.

"ANZ Gold cardholders with Sphere will also receive additional benefits including two points earned for every foreign currency transaction and additional bonus points at participating merchants," said Ms Fagg.

"Participating ANZ Gold cardholders will also be eligible for unique redemption offers and our 'Points Plus Pay' redemption feature, so customers can top up their points by using their ANZ Gold Card to pay for part of the reward," she said.

ANZ has also added new features to ANZ Gold's comprehensive overseas travel and medical insurance benefits with increased cover and ticket replacement, transport and lost luggage assistance service for ANZ Gold Liberty.

ANZ has already converted all its ANZ Gold customers to chip, which offers a secure online shopping guarantee using Verified by Visa, a new authentication technology protocol that is designed to increase security of online transactions by confirming the identity of both the buyer and seller. Cardholders can also choose to shop online via a chip card reader connected to their PC.

ANZ Gold cardholders continue to benefit from features exclusive to Gold card customers, including up to 55 days interest free on purchases, commission free travellers' cheques and 12 months extended warranty on purchases. ANZ Gold can also be linked to an ANZ Access Advantage account, free of account servicing fees.
