Abundant visible gold in new wide Red Hill zone

Diamond drilling at Red Hill has intersected a new wide zone containing abundant visible gold over a true width of ten metres. Drill hole RHD145 is targeting Hawkins Hill/Reward-style mineralisation beneath the White's area at the southern end of Red Hill and has a design depth of 400 metres. At a depth of 204 metres the hole intersected a zone containing 36% quartz with multiple occurrences of visible gold in bedding and splay quartz veins which, on geological logging, is the best intersection ever drilled in the Red Hill area.

This 14.5 metre down hole interval was followed by a further 14 metres of 15% quartz veining carrying indicator minerals with some visible gold. The new zone is hosted by a silt-dominated turbidite sequence sandwiched between wide units of coarser sediments and similar mineralised zones are anticipated to repeat at depth.

The new mineralisation is part of the extensive Red Hill area mineralisation and is expected to have continuity along strike for hundreds of metres. The core is being cut and will be sent to SGS Laboratories in Townsville for Leachwell bottle roll / screen fire assaying with results taking a few weeks.

Further drilling is planned this week to continue outlining the extent of the new zone.
