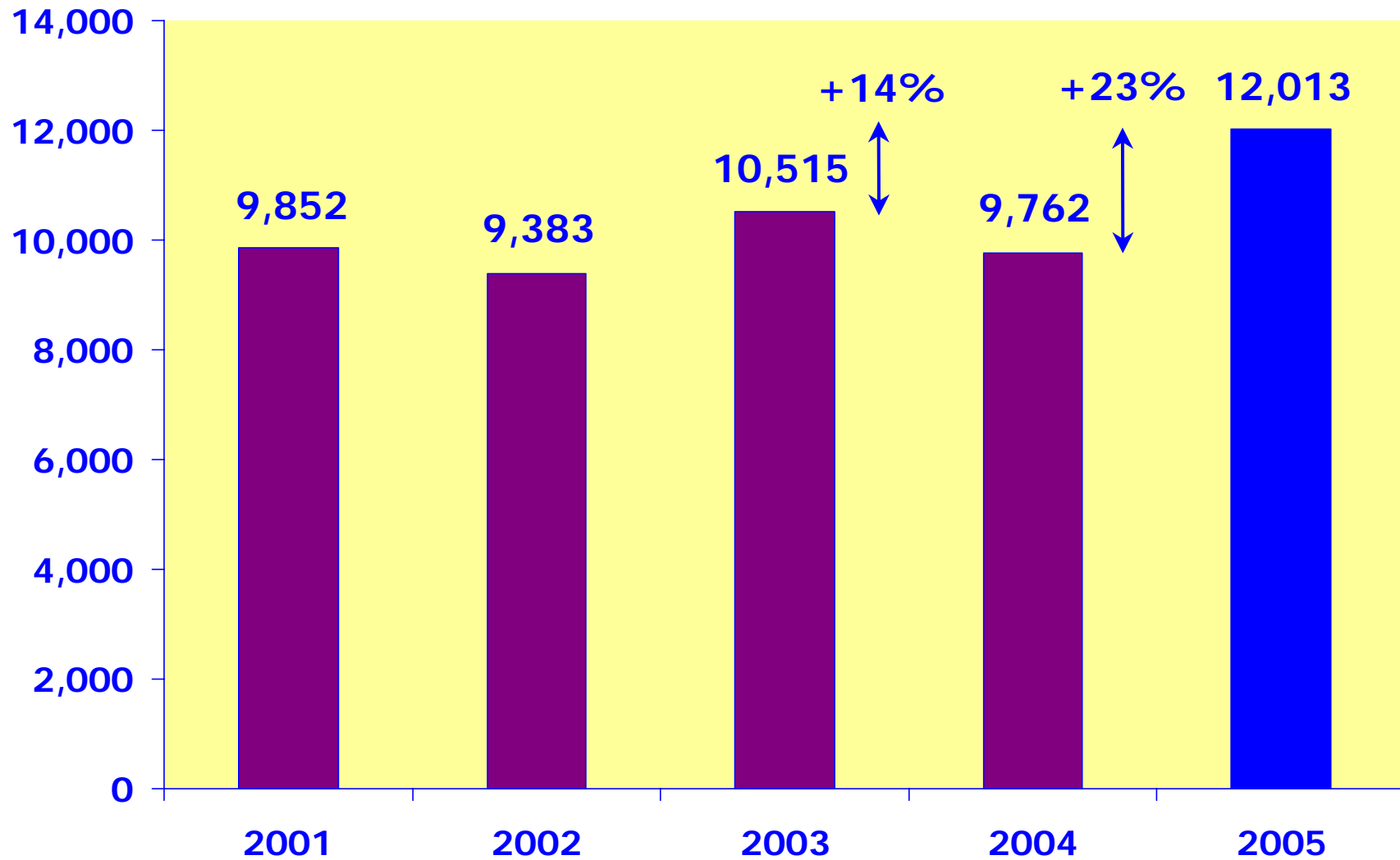

– FY2004/05 (\$ million)

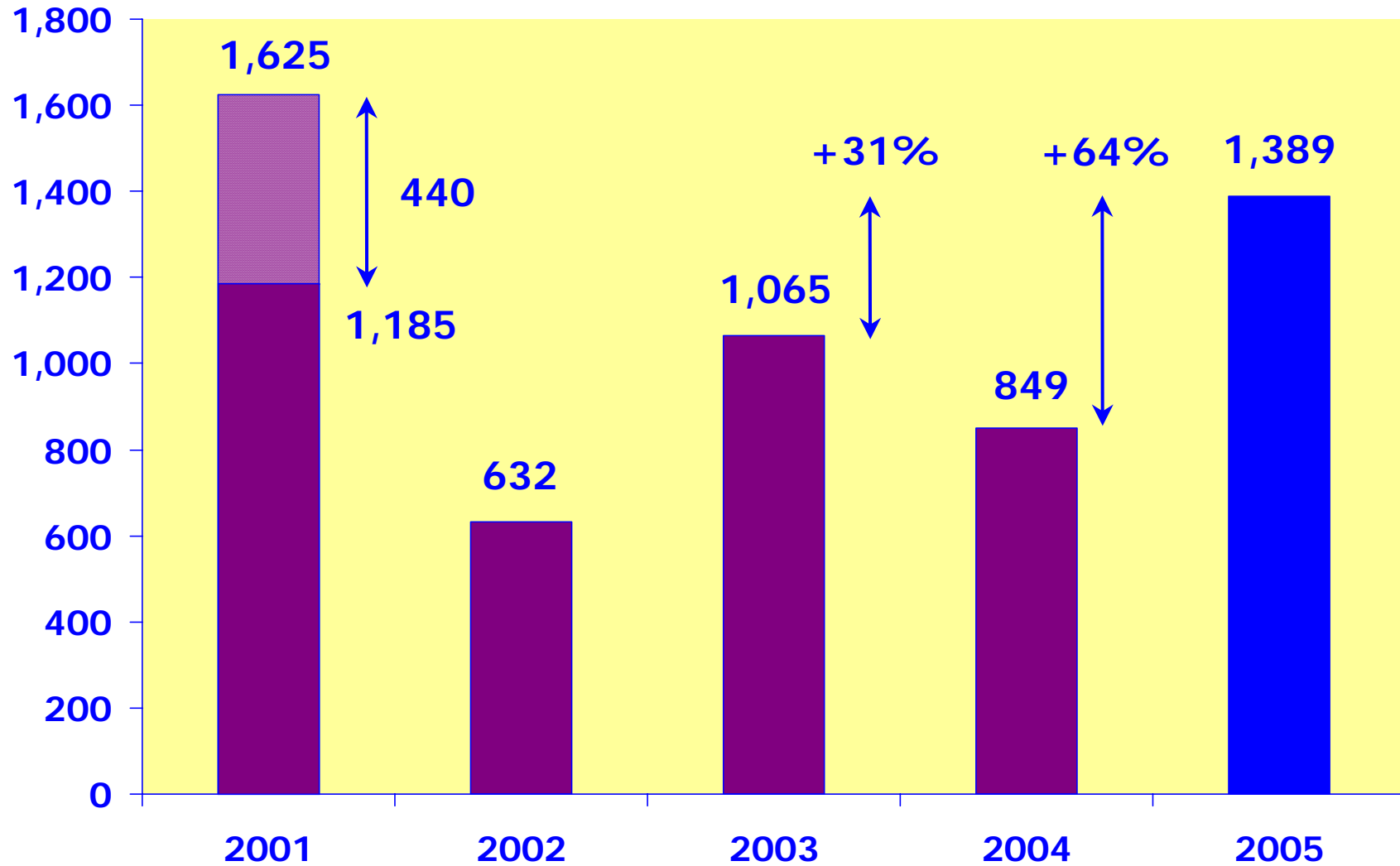

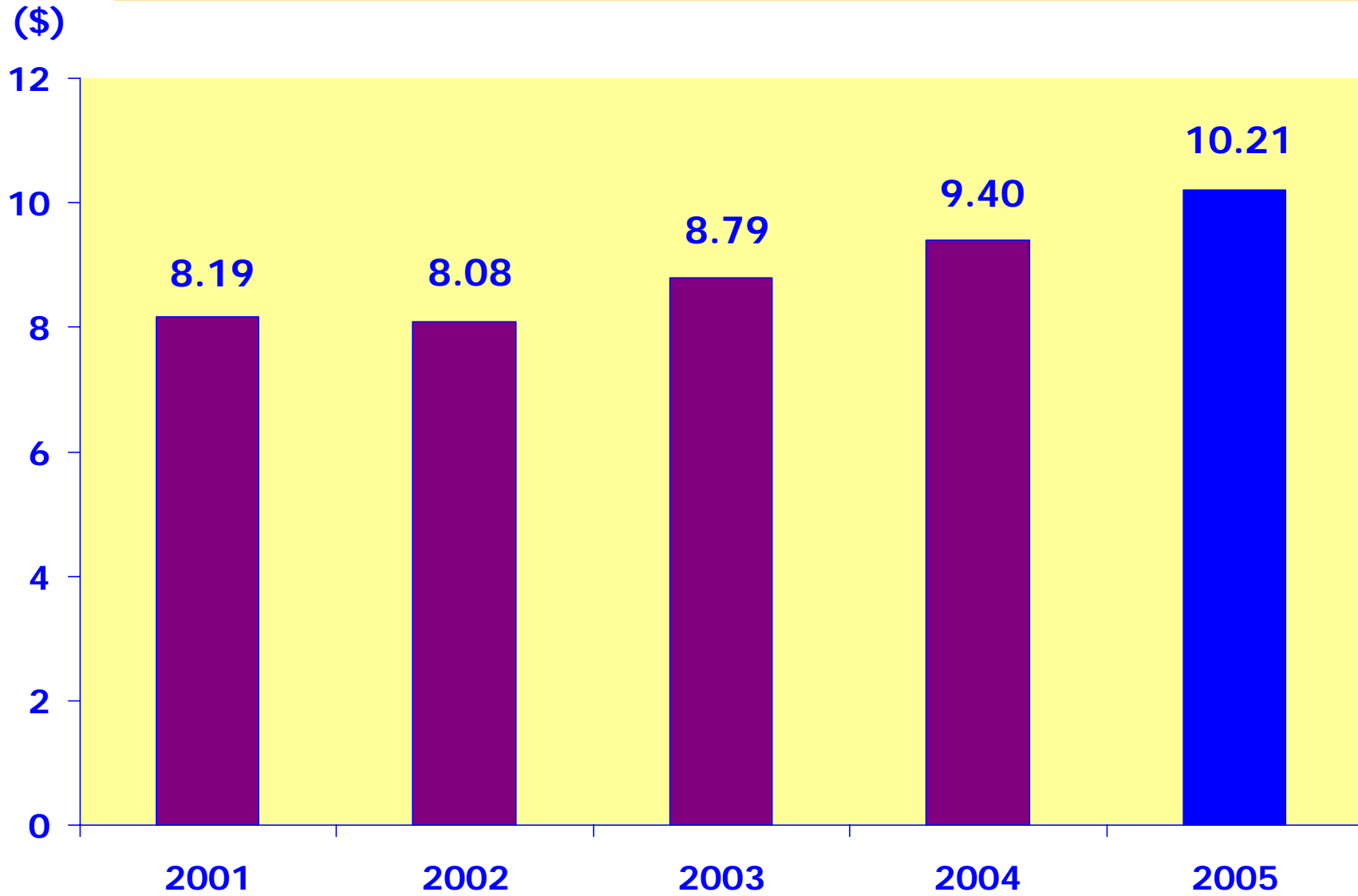
GROUP EARNINGS & DIVIDENDS PER SHARE – FY2004/05

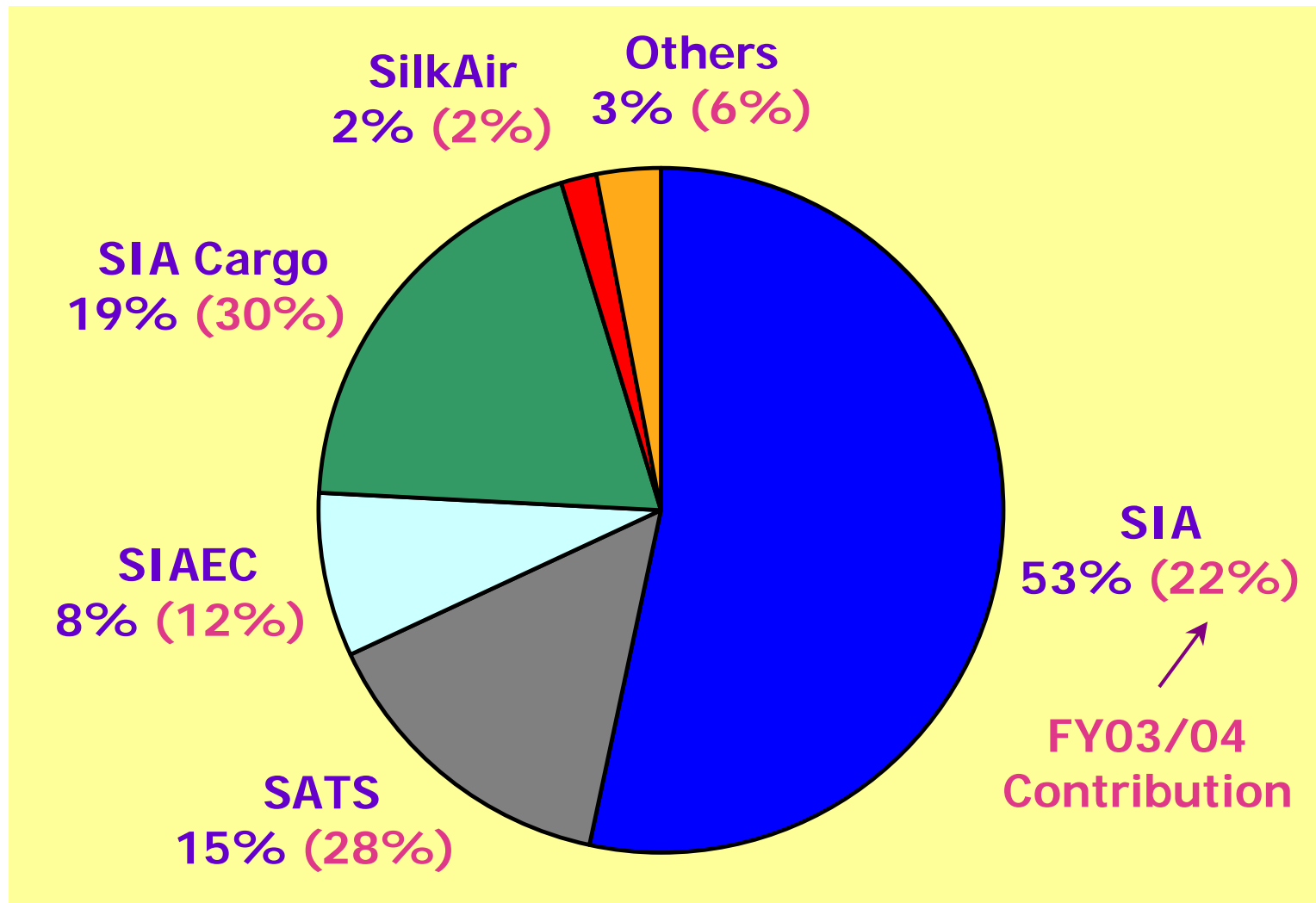

GROUP NET ASSET VALUE PER SHARE – FY2004/05

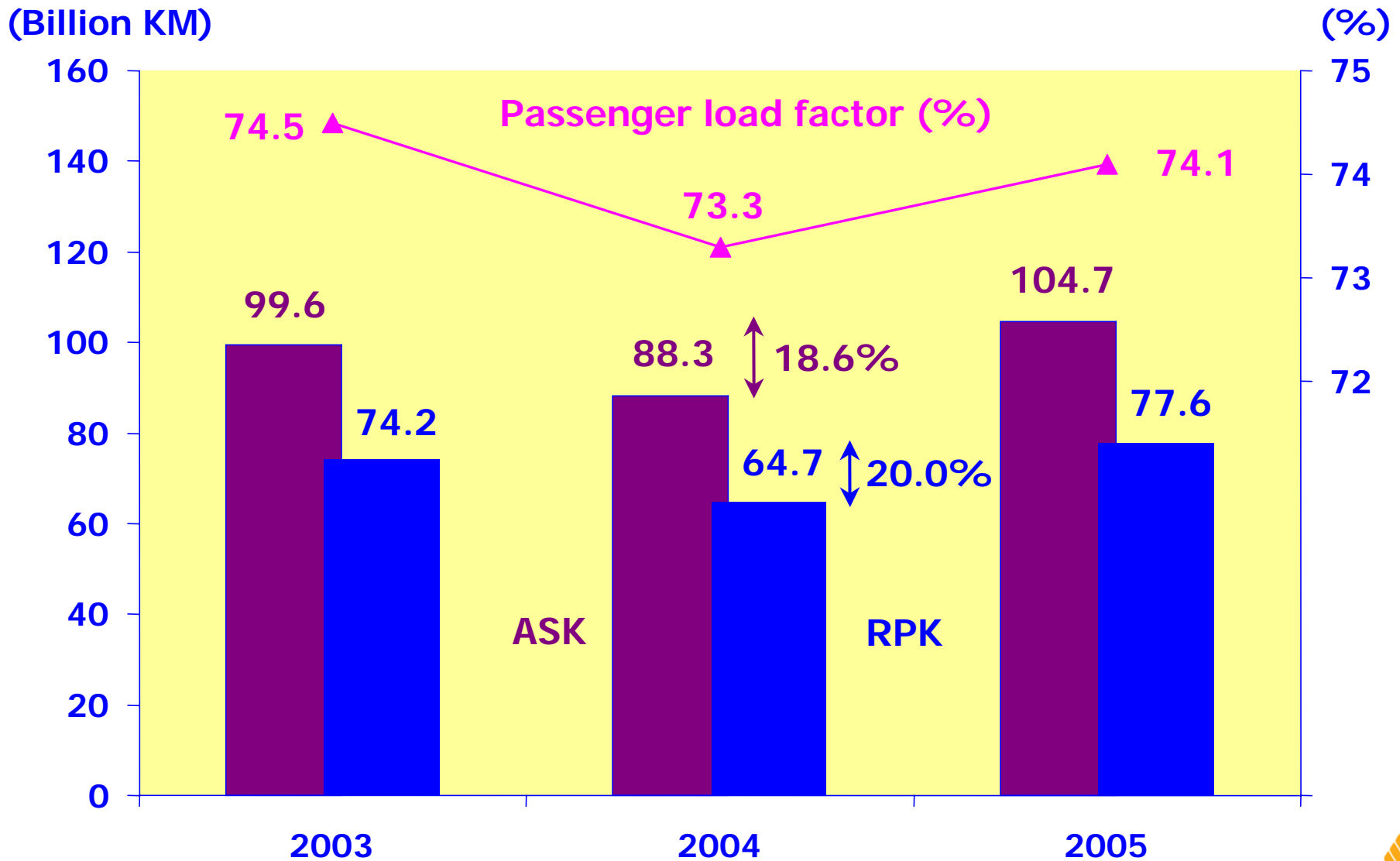


CONTRIBUTION TO GROUP OPERATING PROFIT – FY04/05 vs FY03/04

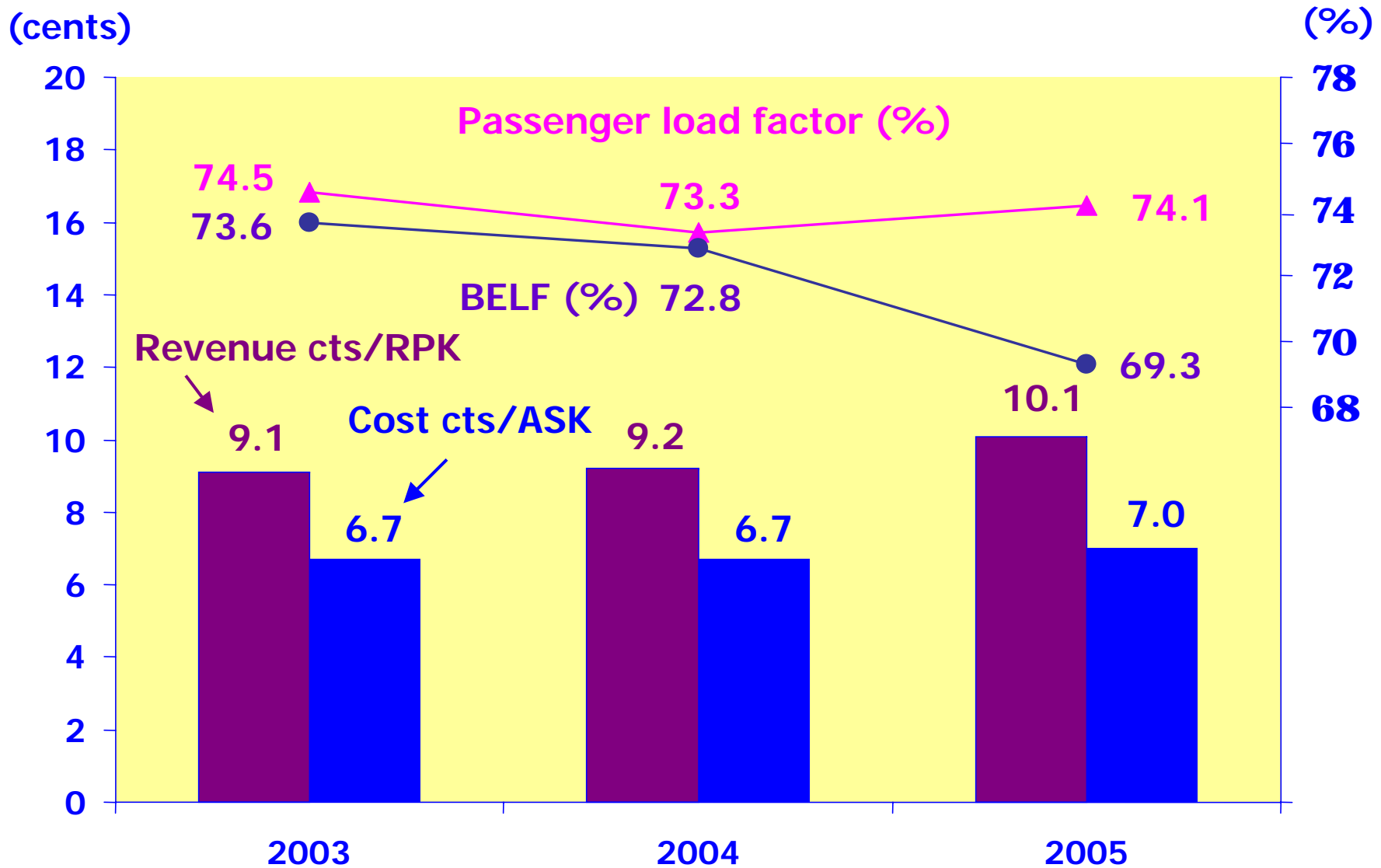

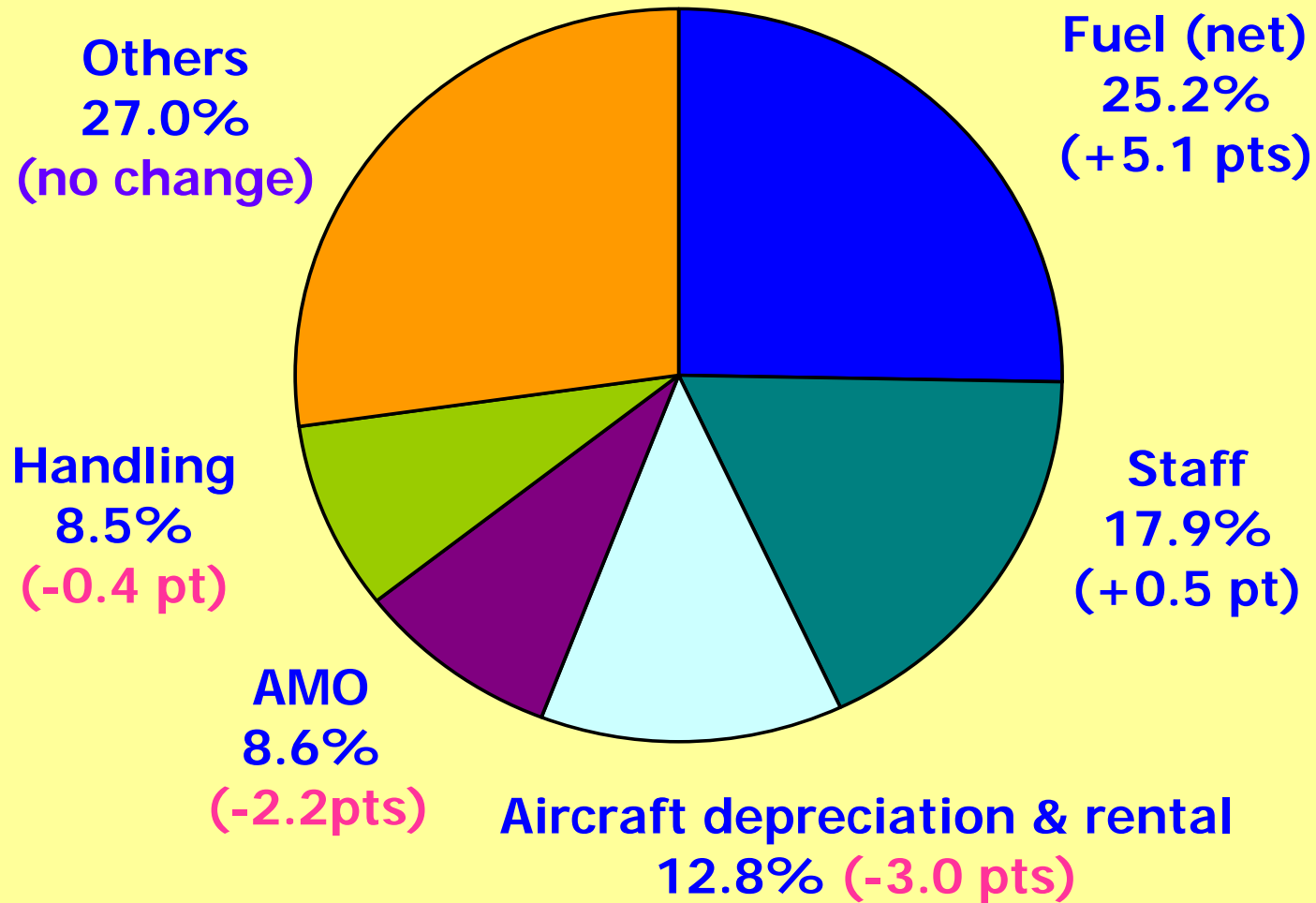
THE PASSENGER AIRLINE COMPANY OPERATING PERFORMANCE – FY2004/05



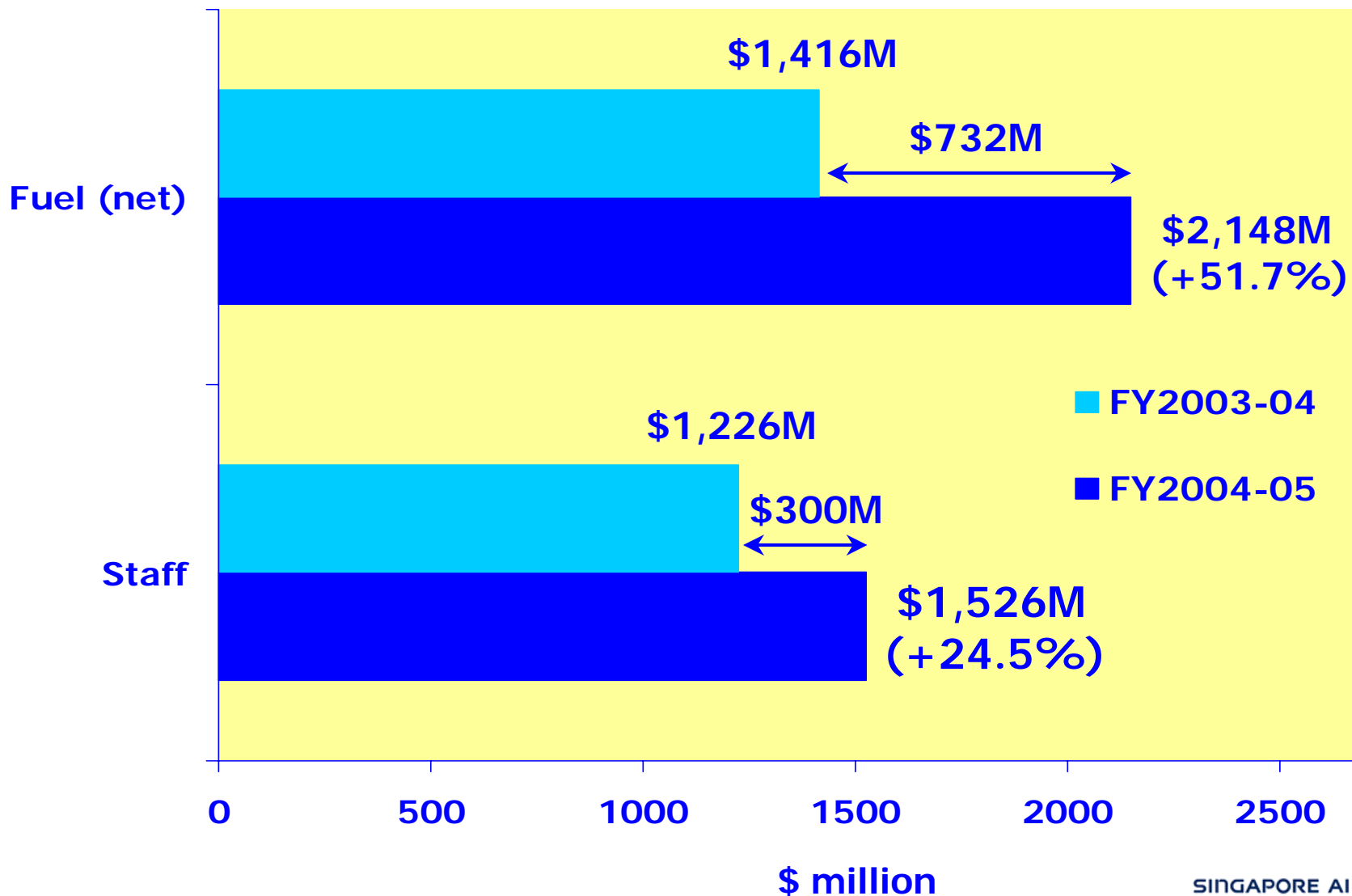
THE PASSENGER AIRLINE COMPANY OPERATING PERFORMANCE – FY04/05



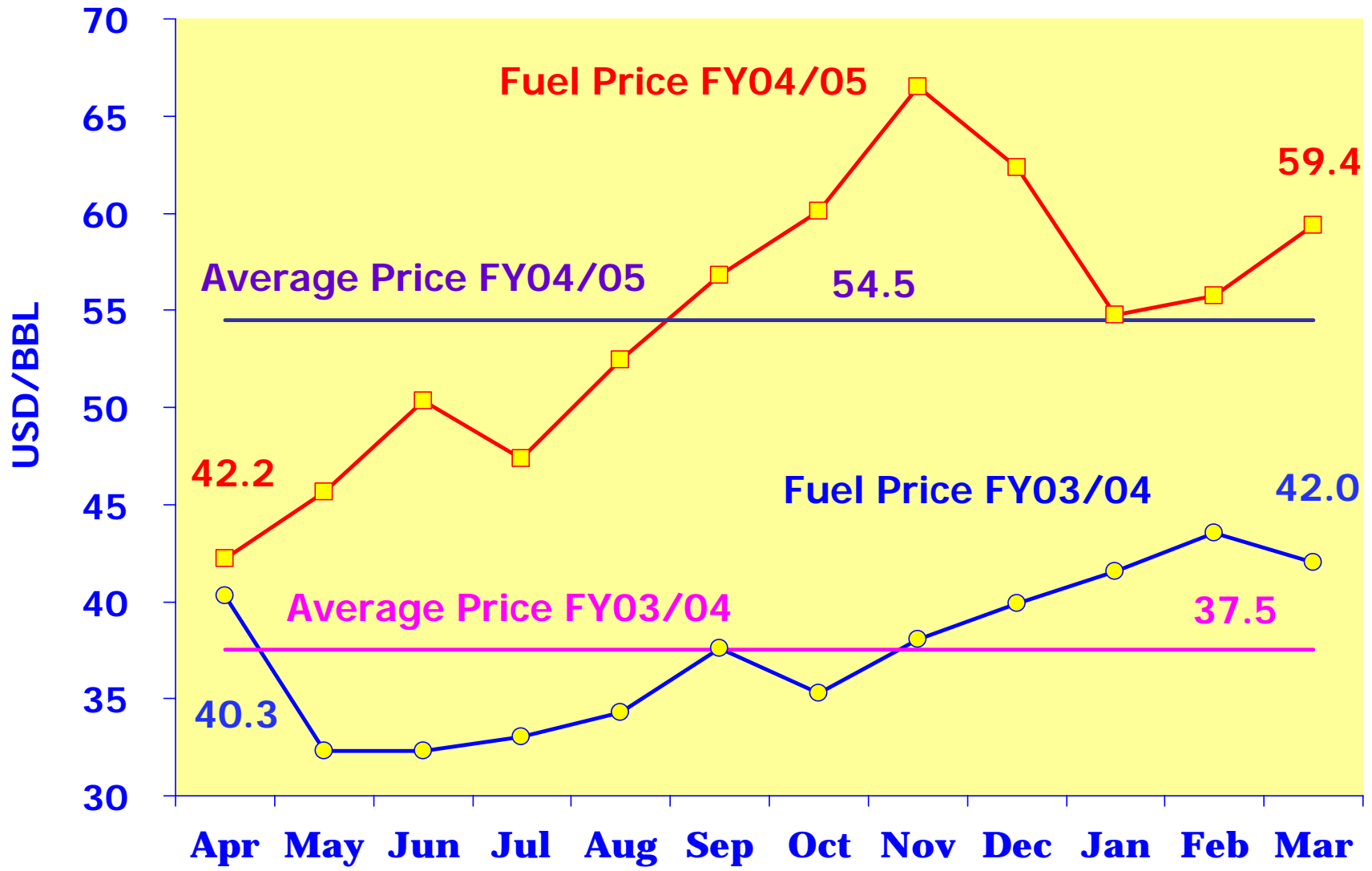
THE PASSENGER AIRLINE COMPANY COST COMPOSITION – FY04/05
