Now OKWAP is the No. 2 brand in China PHS handset market with market share of approximately 28%.</p> <p>Facing the rising ODM business demands from the emerging markets, the Board has decided to properly separate the Own-Brand Manufacturing (OBM) and ODM business operations to better serve the customers and to set up Inventec Appliances (Nanjing) System Corporation in May 2006.</p> <p>To further implement the re-organization, the operational structure for ODM and OBM business are now separated as follows: Mr. Verne Zhang, the General Manager of Inventec Appliances (Jiangning) Corporation and Inventec Appliances (Nanjing) Corporation, will be in charge of the ODM business. Ms. Joyce Chang, the General Manager of Inventec Appliances (Nanjing) System Corporation and Inventec Appliances (Shanghai) International Marketing Corporation, will oversee the OBM business. Ms. Joyce Chang will also be responsible for consolidating the two OKWAP product lines (GSM and PHS handset) in China market.</p> <p>Mr. Jeffrey Lai, the incumbent General Manager of Nanjing Business Unit, is to relocate to Taipei headquarter office in support of future corporate business development and be relieved of his current position as General Manager. As the incumbent board member, Mr. Lai will continue to serve his duty to the Board of Inventec Appliances' China subsidiaries.</p> | | | | |
