Chinese Gymnastic Olympic Gold Medallists Set For Rare Hong Kong Performance

Hong Kong, June 14, 2001 -- China's gymnastic Olympic gold medal squad is set to perform in Hong Kong on July 11, at the Queen Elizabeth Stadium, just ahead of the International Olympic Committee's announcement on the host country of the 2008 Games.

The KCRC – Chinese Gymnastic Gold Medallists Show, which will feature 20 gymnasts including stars such as Li Xiaopeng, Yang Wei, and Ling Jie, is brought to the SAR by TOM.COM LIMITED (TOM) and the Hong Kong Amateur Gymnastic Association (HKAGA). This is the first time a team of such high calibre has appeared in the SAR, and the gymnasts will perform a variety of exercises, including the parallel bars, pommel horse, uneven bars, and floor exercise.

Li, who won two gold medals in Sydney, will perform with fellow team medallists Yang Wei, Huang Xu, Xing Aowei, Zheng Lihui, and Xiao Junfeng. Female gymnasts will include double Olympic medal winner, Ling Jie, and team mate Dong Fangxiao.

Hong Kong's Kowloon-Canton Railway Corporation (KCRC) is sponsoring the event to both demonstrate its support of China's Olympic bid, and as part of on-going community programme to encourage sports participation amongst Hong Kong's youth. KCRC will invite around 1,500 students, from 300 secondary schools located along KCR routes, to the show free of charge.

Commented Ida Leung, Corporate Affairs Manager - Publicity of KCRC, "For these youngsters to witness sporting excellence first hand can provide no better inspiration. These Chinese gymnasts have achieved international greatness and represent superb role models for aspiring local athletes."

TOM, organiser of the event, is bringing the gymnasts to the SAR in line with its policy of organising top level sporting events in Greater China, and to demonstrate its capabilities in planning, organising and staging events of this stature.

Commented Michelle Leung, Chief Operating Officer of TOM.COM LIMITED, "We are delighted to be bringing a sporting event of this calibre to the SAR. The event will serve to showcase TOM's event marketing capabilities, and is an illustration of our commitment to continue to promote China's sports industry. TOM is proud to support China's Olympic bid."

Dr. Cheung Siu Yin, Chairperson of HKAGA said, "The Association would like to take this excellent opportunity to promote and develop gymnastic activities in Hong Kong. Through the show and the gymnasts' outstanding performance, we believe we will instill a healthy, sporting spirit in the people of Hong Kong."

The event is also receiving valuable assistance from Chinese Gymnastic Association and Administration Centre for the Sport of Gymnastics.

The arrival of the Olympic gymnast squad in Hong Kong is timely, ahead of the announcement of the 2008 Olympic host city, scheduled for July 13 (Hong Kong time).

Limited tickets are still available for the event, which will start at 8pm on July 11, from URBTIX outlets and are priced at HK\$80.

ATV is the official TV broadcaster which owns exclusive broadcast rights for the show in Hong Kong. The show will be broadcast delayed live at 12:05am on July 12, repeated at 3pm on July 14.
