May

Gold Peak Industries (Taiwan) Limited ("GPIT") placed 9 million and 1.4 million new shares of NT\$10 each at NT\$24 each respectively to Meiloon Industrial Co., Ltd and China Development Industrial Bank. Total proceeds amounted to NT\$250 million (\$14.1 million). The Group's interest in GPIT was accordingly diluted to 75.1%.

June

August

Gold Peak Industries (Taiwan) Limited commenced mass production of Lithium Ion cylindrical batteries.

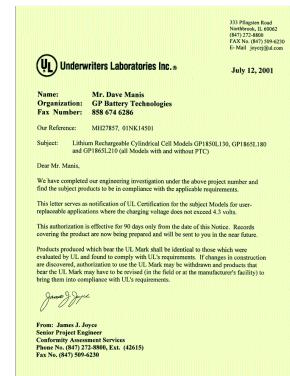
May
