SYDNEY Australia, 30 October 2013: Benitec Biopharma Limited ("the Company") advised on 23 October 2013 that it would issue 955,002 fully paid ordinary shares on 30 October 2013 to vendors of Tacere. The following Appendix 3B refers to this issue. The issue of these shares represents the final transaction for completion of the Tacere acquisition. The 955,002 fully paid ordinary shares were agreed to be issued 12 months after completion of the acquisition of Tacere.

As previously advised, the acquisition agreement between Benitec and the Tacere vendors limits the value of all shares (including the above shares) which may be sold by the Tacere vendors after 30 October 2013 to AUD \$180,000 per month in total.
