As at 31 March 2010, the Group's unsecured borrowings that were repayable in one year or less stood at US\$62.0 million. The Group continues to have committed banking lines to meet its funding requirements.

The Group's long term borrowings of US\$378.5 million are secured on three hotels owned by the Group with a total net book value of US\$568.3 million.

In addition, another hotel with a net book value of US\$243.5 million is charged as security for a letter of credit facility from a bank as a result of a guarantee given by the Group. The maximum liability in any one year under the guarantee is US\$42.0 million (£27.7 million) and the maximum aggregate liability under the guarantee is US\$83.9 million (£55.4 million).

#### **Income Statement**

Profit after tax for the nine months ended 31 March 2010 stood at US\$24.8 million, a slight decrease of 3.5% as compared to US\$25.7 million in the previous corresponding period. The following factors affected the profit after tax:

#### Revenue

For the nine months ended 31 March 2010, revenues of the Group stood at US\$251.7 million, which was 5.8% below that of the previous corresponding period. This was mainly due to losses suffered in the gaming segment as well as reduced property sales as the Group moves to exit its property development business. There was also a slight decline of 1.3% from hotel revenues.

#### Bass Strait oil and gas royalty

Income from the Bass Strait oil and gas royalty in Australia increased by 3.0% principally due to the strengthening of the AUD, which increased by 21% compared to the previous corresponding period. However this was partly offset by lower royalties received as a result of lower average crude oil and gas prices for the current nine month period as compared to the previous corresponding period.

#### Other operating income

Other operating income increased by 36.7% for the nine months ended 31 March 2010 due mainly to one-off liquidation proceeds received from past litigation action taken against certain parties.

#### Direct costs of raw materials, consumables and services

Direct costs reduced by 4.8% in tandem with the decline in revenue for the nine months ended 31 March 2010.

#### Personnel expenses

The reduction in personnel expenses was chiefly due to the full period impact of cost rationalisation efforts undertaken in the hotel business in the previous financial year.

#### Net financing costs

Higher net financing costs for the nine months ended 31 March 2010 were predominantly attributable to lower interest income received in the current period.

#### Income tax expense

Higher income tax expenses were mainly due to a provision made for tax on the Group's royalty income. Previously, the tax liability arising from the Group's royalty income was offset by past tax losses.

#### Statement of Comprehensive Income

Total comprehensive income recorded a negative figure of US\$27.5 million for the nine months ended 31 March 2010. This was mainly due to a foreign exchange translation difference of US\$54.1 million as a result of translating the books of the Group's UK subsidiaries which are denominated in GBP into the Group's reporting currency, which is USD. The GBP declined by 8% against the USD, from 1.66 in June 2009 to 1.52 in March 2010.

This was partly offset by a positive mark-to-market valuation of one of the Group's investments.

#### **Statement of Financial Position**

The Group's net assets as at 31 March 2010 decreased by 4% to US\$0.96 billion from US\$1.00 billion as at 30 June 2009 due principally to a net translation difference of US\$54.1 million, as explained in the Statement of Comprehensive Income section.

Set out below are factors other than the impact of currency translation that affected the Group's major assets and liabilities as at 31 March 2010:

- Cash and cash equivalents increased due mainly to operational funds generated from the hotel, property development and gaming segments.
- b) Trade and other payables decreased due mainly to scheduled settlement of creditor liabilities.
- c) Loans and borrowings reduced due mainly to scheduled loan repayments.

#### **Cash Flow Statement**

There was a higher net cash inflow of US\$9.2 million for the nine months ended 31 March 2010 as compared to a cash outflow of US\$20.8 million in the previous corresponding period due mainly to lower dividend payments as well as lower hotel capex spending in the current period.
