### NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Annual General Meeting of the Company will be held at Stork Room, 1st Floor, Mandarin Oriental, 5 Connaught Road, Central, Hong Kong on Tuesday, 22 May 2007 at 12:00 noon for the following purposes:

1. To receive and adopt the Audited Consolidated Financial Statements and the Reports of the Directors and the Auditors for the year ended 31 December 2006;
2. To declare a final dividend of HK28 cents per share in respect of the year ended 31 December 2006;
3. To re-elect the following Directors:
  - (a) Dr. William FUNG Kwok Lun as Non-executive Director;
  - (b) Mr. Joseph Chua PHI as Executive Director;
  - (c) Mr. John Estmond STRICKLAND as Independent Non-executive Director;
  - (d) Dr. FU Yu Ning as Independent Non-executive Director;
  - (e) Prof. LEE Hau Leung as Independent Non-executive Director;
4. To re-appoint PricewaterhouseCoopers as Auditors and authorise the Board of Directors to fix their remuneration;
5. As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

**“THAT:**

- (a) subject to paragraph (c), the exercise by the Directors of the Company during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) of all the powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with additional shares in the capital of the Company and to make or grant offers, agreements and options which might require the exercise of such powers be generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the approval in paragraph (a) shall authorise the Directors of the Company during the Relevant Period to make or grant offers, agreements and options which might require the exercise of such powers after the end of the Relevant Period;
- (c) the aggregate nominal amount of share capital allotted or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted (whether pursuant to an option or otherwise) by the Directors of the Company pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a), otherwise than pursuant to (i) a Rights Issue (as hereinafter defined); (ii) the exercise of options granted under any share option scheme adopted by the Company; or (iii) any scrip dividend or similar arrangement providing for the allotment of shares in lieu of the whole or part of a dividend on shares of the Company in accordance with the Bye-laws of the Company, shall not exceed the aggregate of (aa) 20 per cent of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue on the date of passing this Resolution

plus (bb) (if the Directors of the Company are so authorised by a separate ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Company) the nominal amount of share capital of the Company repurchased by the Company subsequent to the passing of this Resolution (up to a maximum equivalent to 10 per cent of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue on the date of passing this Resolution), and the said approval shall be limited accordingly; and

(d) for the purposes of this Resolution:

“**Relevant Period**” means the period from the passing of this Resolution until whichever is the earliest of :

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Bye-laws of the Company or the Companies Act 1981 of Bermuda (as amended) to be held; and
- (iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given under this Resolution by ordinary resolution of the shareholders in general meeting; and

“**Rights Issue**” means an offer of shares open for a period fixed by the Directors of the Company to holders of ordinary shares on the register of members of the Company on a fixed record date in proportion to their then holdings of such shares (subject to such exclusion or other arrangements as the Directors of the Company may deem necessary or expedient in relation to fractional entitlements or having regard to any restrictions or obligations under the laws of, or the requirements of any recognised regulatory body or any stock exchange in, any territory outside Hong Kong).”;

6. As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

“**THAT:**

- (a) subject to paragraph (b) below, the exercise by the Directors of the Company during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) of all the powers of the Company to purchase shares of the Company be generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the aggregate nominal amount of shares which may be purchased in The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) or any other stock exchange recognised for this purpose by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange under the Hong Kong Code on Share Repurchases pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) above shall not exceed 10 per cent of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue on the date of passing this Resolution, and the said approval shall be limited accordingly; and
- (c) for the purposes of this Resolution:

“**Relevant Period**” means the period from the passing of this Resolution until whichever is the earliest of :

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Bye-laws of the Company or the Companies Act 1981 of Bermuda (as amended) to be held; and

(iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given under this Resolution by ordinary resolution of the shareholders in general meeting.”;

7. As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

“**THAT** the Directors of the Company be authorised to exercise the powers of the Company referred to in paragraph (a) of the resolution set out as resolution 5 in the notice of this Meeting in respect of the share capital of the Company referred to in sub-paragraph (bb) of the paragraph (c) of such resolution.”

- (1) A member entitled to attend and vote at the above meeting may appoint one or, if he holds two or more shares, more proxies to attend and vote instead of him. A proxy need not be a member of the Company.
- (2) In order to be valid, a form of proxy and the power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority shall be deposited with the Company's Hong Kong branch share registrar, Abacus Share Registrars Limited, at 26th Floor, Tesbury Centre, 28 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time for holding the meeting or any adjourned meeting. The proxy form will be published on the website of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited and can also be downloaded from the Company's website: [www.idsgroup.com](http://www.idsgroup.com).
- (3) The Register of Shareholders will be closed from 16 May 2007 to 22 May 2007 (both days inclusive) during which period no transfer of Shares will be registered. In order to qualify for the proposed final dividend, all transfers accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's Hong Kong branch registrars, Abacus Share Registrars Limited, at 26th Floor, Tesbury Centre, 28 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not later than 4:00 p.m. on 15 May 2007.
- (4) The Chairman of the Meeting will demand a poll on each of the questions submitted for determination at the 2007 Annual General Meeting.
