Lifeline Express Hong Kong Foundation, a charity in Hong Kong, was established in 1996 to raise fund for the operation of Lifeline Express Hospital Eye-Trains (the Eye-Train). The custom built Eye-Trains are equipped with the latest medical equipment and eye care technology. Each four compartment Eye-Train consists of a consultation clinic, a sanitization room, two operating theatres, a recovery room (with beds for patients), a multi-function conference room and living quarters for the medical team. The Eye-Train not only provides free surgical operations for poverty stricken cataract patients, but also facilitates cooperation between ophthalmologists from overseas and Mainland China. The first Eye-Train embarked on its mission on 1 July 1997, other new trains were commissioned in 1999, 2002, and 2009, respectively. Nowadays, there are four Eye-Trains in continuous operation, which together cure about 12,000 cataract patients each year.
