GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE AND REPURCHASE SHARES, RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS, RE-APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR, REFRESHMENT OF SCHEME MANDATE LIMIT AND NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

INTRODUCTION

At the forthcoming AGM, resolutions will be proposed to seek the Shareholders' approval for, among other things, (i) the granting of the Issue Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate; (ii) the re-election of Directors; (iii) the re-appointment of auditor; and (iv) the refreshment of Scheme Mandate Limit.

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding (i) the proposed renewal of the general mandates to issue and allot Shares and to repurchase Shares of the Company; (ii) the proposed re-election of Directors; (iii) the proposed re-appointment of auditor of the Company; and (iv) the proposed refreshment of Scheme Mandate Limit and to seek your approval of the resolutions relating to these matters at the AGM.

ISSUE MANDATE

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Issue Mandate, and authorise the extension of the Issue Mandate to issue and allot the Shares repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate, details of which are set out in ordinary resolutions no. 4 and 6 of the AGM Notice. The Shares of the Company which may be issued and allotted pursuant to the Issue Mandate is limited to a maximum of 20% of the total number of issued shares of the Company at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Issue Mandate. On the basis that 80,000,000 Shares are in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date and no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, exercise in full of the Issue Mandate (without being extended by the number of Shares (if any) repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate) could result in up to 16,000,000 Shares being issued and allotted by the Company.

REPURCHASE MANDATE

An ordinary resolution will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate, details of which are set out in ordinary resolution no. 5 of the AGM Notice. The Shares of the Company which may be repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate is limited to a maximum of 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate. On the basis that 80,000,000 Shares are in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date and no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate could result in up to 8,000,000 Shares being repurchased by the Company.

An explanatory statement as required under the GEM Listing Rules, in particular Rule 13.08, giving certain information regarding the Repurchase Mandate, is set out in the Appendix I hereto.

RE-ELECTION OF THE DIRECTORS

Pursuant to the Articles, (i) Mr. Chan Kit Lung Andy will retire at the AGM and, being eligible, offer himself for re-election as executive Directors; and (ii) Mr. Wong Sui Chi, Ms. Xiao Ping and Ms. Ha Yee Lan Elaine will retire at the AGM and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election as independent non-executive Director. Particulars of the Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II of this circular.

RE-APPOINTMENT OF THE AUDITOR

Elite Partners CPA Limited will retire as the auditor of the Company at the AGM and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-appointment.

The Board proposed to re-appoint Elite Partners CPA Limited as the auditor of the Company and to hold office until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company.

REFRESHMENT OF SCHEME MANDATE LIMIT

The Share Option Scheme was adopted by the Company on 23 June 2017. Apart from the Share Option Scheme, the Company has no other share option scheme currently in force.

The Company has granted 8,000,000 options, 8,000,000 options and 8,000,000 options on 17 April 2018, 10 April 2019 and 18 May 2020 respectively. As at the Latest Practicable Date, 8,000,000 options were lapsed and no options so granted had been exercised nor cancelled.

During the period from date of adoption, 23 June 2017, to the Latest Practicable Date, (i) 16,000,000 share options were granted to the eligible participants under the Share Option Scheme; (ii) 8,000,000 share options were lapsed; and (iii) no share options were exercises or cancelled. During the period from date of last refreshment of Scheme Mandate Limit, 17 June 2019, to the Latest Practicable Date, (i) 8,000,000 share options were granted to the eligible participants under the Share Option Scheme; (ii) 8,000,000 share options were lapsed; and (iii) no share options were exercises or cancelled.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, a total of 16,000,000 outstanding share options entitle the holders thereof to subscribe for 16,000,000 Shares, representing 20% of the number of issued shares. APPENDIX I

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required pursuant to Rule 13.08 and other relevant provisions of the GEM Listing Rules, to provide you with the requisite information for your consideration of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

On the basis that 80,000,000 Shares are in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date and no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate could result in up to 8,000,000 Shares being repurchased by the Company during the period from the passing of resolution no. 5 set out in the AGM Notice up to (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles or any applicable laws of the Cayman Islands to be held; or (iii) the passing of an ordinary resolution by Shareholders in general meeting revoking, varying and renewing the Repurchase Mandate, whichever occurs first.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders. Repurchases of Shares will only be made when the Directors believe that such repurchases will benefit the Company and the Shareholders. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value of the Company and/or its earnings per share.

3. FUNDING AND EFFECT OF REPURCHASES

Repurchases made pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate would be funded out of funds legally available for the purpose in accordance with the Company's memorandum of association, the Articles, the Companies Law and other applicable laws of the Cayman Islands. A listed company may not repurchase its own securities on GEM for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange. Under the Companies Law, repurchases by the Company may only be made out of profits of the Company or out of the proceeds of a fresh issue of Shares made for the purpose, or, if so authorised by the Articles and subject to the provisions of the Companies Law, out of capital.

Any premium payable on a redemption or purchase over the par value of the Shares to be purchased must be provided for out of profits of the Company or out of the Company's share premium account, or, if so authorised by the Articles and subject to the provisions of the Companies Law, out of capital. Taking into account the current working capital position of the Company, the Directors consider that, if the Repurchase Mandate was to be exercised in full, it might have a material adverse effect on the working capital and/or the gearing position of the Company as compared with the position as at 31 December 2019, being the date of its latest published audited financial statements. However, the Directors do not intend to make any repurchases to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements or the gearing position of the Company which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

4. UNDERTAKING

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the GEM Listing Rules, the Articles and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

5. INTENTION TO SELL SHARES

None of the Directors and, to the best of their knowledge, having made all reasonable enquiries, none of their respective close associates, have any present intention, in the event that the proposal on the Repurchase Mandate is approved by Shareholders, to sell Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries.

6. TAKEOVER CODE CONSEQUENCE

If a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases on the Company exercising its powers to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purpose of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code.

On the basis that the issued share capital of the Company remains unchanged up to date of the AGM, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full, the attributable shareholding of Fortune Time Enterprises Limited would be increased to approximately 34.69% of the issued share capital of the Company. Fortune Time Enterprises Limited will be obliged to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Directors have no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent that will result in a requirement of any of the above Shareholder(s) or any other persons to make a general offer under the Takeovers Code or the number of Shares in the hands of the public falling below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25%.

The Directors are not aware of any consequences which could arise under the Takeovers Code as a consequence of any repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in full.
