for the quarter ended 31 December 2013

Sydney, 31 January 2014: Benitec Biopharma Limited (ASX: BLT) today lodged with ASX the company's quarterly cash flow report Appendix 4C for period ended 31 December 2013.

Benitec held \$5.17 million in cash at 31 December 2013, compared to \$6.2 million at 30 September 2013. Net operating cash flow for the quarter was (\$1.0) million, and included scientific and business development expenditure of \$0.7 million. In this quarter the company received a tax refund in the United States of \$465,063.

Benitec announced on 3 June 2013 that the company had committed to moving Tribetarna™, its non-small cell lung cancer therapeutic, into clinical development. The Company is using European-based clinical research organisation Clinical Trials Group (CTGCRO) to manage both the initial clinical development and trials. Benitec made pre-payments in the six months to 31 December 2013 in order to secure favourable commercial terms with CTGCRO for the conduct of the trials. The cash at hand does not include the pre-payments. Scientific and business development expenditure for the year to date includes the CTGCRO pre-payments.

Share issue net proceeds during the period to 31 December 2013 totalled \$9.6 million and included \$2.8 million from the Share Purchase Plan.

About Benitec Biopharma Limited: Benitec Biopharma Limited is an ASX-listed biotechnology company (ASX Code: BLT) based in Sydney, Australia. The company has a pipeline of in-house and partnered therapeutic programs based on its patented gene-silencing technology, ddRNAi. Benitec is developing treatments for chronic and life- threatening human conditions such as hepatitis C, hepatitis B, wet age-related macular degeneration, cancer- associated pain, drug resistant lung cancer and oculopharyngeal muscular dystrophy based on this technology. In addition, Benitec has licensed ddRNAi technology to other biopharmaceutical companies who are progressing their programs towards the clinic for applications including HIV/AIDS, retinitis pigmentosa and Huntington's disease.
