Assuming that there will be no change in the issued share capital of the Company between the date of this announcement and the completion of the Placing, the 86,390,000 Placing Shares under the Placing represent (i) approximately 20.00% of the existing issued share capital of the Company of 431,992,000 Shares as at the date of this announcement; and (ii) approximately 16.67% of the issued share capital of the Company as enlarged by the allotment and issue of the Placing Shares. The aggregate nominal value of the Placing Shares under the Placing will be HK\$863,900.

The Placing Price of HK\$0.41 represents a discount of approximately 19.61% to the benchmarked price of the Shares, which is the higher of (i) the closing price of HK\$0.510 as quoted on the Stock Exchange on the date of the Placing Agreement; and (ii) the average closing price of HK\$0.480 in the last 5 trading days prior to the date of the Placing Agreement.

The Placing is conditional upon, among other things, the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange granting or agreeing to grant the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Placing Shares.

Number of Placing Shares

Assuming that there will be no change in the issued share capital of the Company between the date of this announcement and the completion of the Placing, the 86,390,000 Placing Shares under the Placing represent (i) approximately 20.00% of the existing issued share capital of the Company of 431,992,000 Shares as at the date of this announcement; and (ii) approximately 16.67% of the issued share capital of the Company as enlarged by the allotment and issue of the Placing Shares. The aggregate nominal value of the Placing Shares under the Placing will be HK\$863,900.

Ranking of Placing Shares

The Placing Shares under the Placing will rank, upon issue, pari passu in all respects with the Shares in issue on the date of allotment and issue of the Placing Shares.

Placing Price

The Placing Price of HK\$0.41 represents a discount of approximately 19.61% to the benchmarked price of the Shares, which is the higher of (i) the closing price of HK\$0.510 as quoted on the Stock Exchange on the date of the Placing Agreement; and (ii) the average closing price of HK\$0.480 in the last 5 trading days prior to the date of the Placing Agreement.

The Placing Price was determined with reference to the prevailing market price of the Shares and was negotiated on an arm's length basis between the Company and the Placing Agent. The Directors consider that the terms of the Placing are on normal commercial terms and are fair and reasonable based on the current market conditions. Hence, the Directors consider that the Placing is in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

General Mandate to Allot and Issue the Placing Shares

The Placing Shares will be issued under the General Mandate granted to the Directors by resolution of the Shareholders passed at the AGM, subject to the limit up to 20% of the then issued share capital of the Company as at the date of the AGM. Under the General Mandate, the Company is authorized to issue up to 86,390,000 new Shares. Up to the date of this announcement, no new Shares have been issued under the General Mandate. Accordingly, the issue of the Placing Shares is not subject to the approval of the Shareholders.

The Group is principally engaged in investment in listed and unlisted companies established in the PRC, Hong Kong, Australia and Macau.

The maximum gross proceeds from the Placing will be approximately HK\$35.42 million. The maximum net proceeds from the Placing will amount to approximately HK\$34.53 million which is intended to be used for the general working capital of the Group and potential investments to be identified. The net proceeds raised per Placing Share will be approximately HK\$0.40 per Share.

The Directors have considered various ways of raising funds and believe that the Placing represents an opportunity to raise capital for the Group while broadening its Shareholder and capital base. Accordingly, the Directors are of the view that the Placing is in the best interest of the Company and its Shareholders as a whole.
