Poll Results of the Annual General Meeting held on 28 June 2010 and Payment of Final Dividend

- The Board of the Company hereby announces that all the proposed resolutions set out in the notice convening the AGM were duly passed by the shareholders of the Company by way of poll at the AGM held on 28 June 2010.
- The declaration and payment of a final dividend of RMB0.1108 per share (equivalent to HK\$0.12658 per share) (inclusive of applicable tax) for the year ended 31 December 2009 were approved at the AGM. The final dividend will be paid on or about 30 July 2010.

Results of the AGM

The board of directors (the "Board") of China Communications Services Corporation Limited (the "Company") hereby announces that all the proposed resolutions set out in the notice convening the 2009 annual general meeting (the "AGM") dated 19 April 2010 were duly passed by the shareholders of the Company by way of poll at the AGM held on Monday, 28 June 2010 at No. 19, Chaoyangmen Beidajie, Dongcheng District, Beijing, PRC.

The total number of issued shares of the Company as at the date of the AGM was 5,771,682,000, which was the total number of shares entitling the holders to attend and vote for or against any of the resolutions proposed at the AGM. There were no restrictions on any shareholders casting votes on any of the proposed resolutions at the AGM. Shareholders and authorized proxies holding an aggregate of 4,498,600,367 shares, representing 77.94 % of the total voting shares of the Company were present at the AGM. The holding of the AGM was in compliance with the requirements of the Company Law of the People's Republic of China and the provisions of the articles of association of the Company (the "Articles").

All the resolutions, which were voted on by poll, were approved by the shareholders of the Company. The poll results in respect of the proposed resolutions at the AGM were as follows:

Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited was the scrutineer for the vote-taking at the AGM.

Payment of Final Dividend

The declaration and payment of a final dividend of RMB0.1108 per share (equivalent to HK\$0.12658 per share) (inclusive of applicable tax) for the year ended 31 December 2009 were approved at the AGM. The payment shall be made to shareholders whose names appeared on the register of members of the Company on 28 June 2010. According to the Articles, dividends will be denominated and declared in Renminbi. Dividends on domestic shares will be paid in Renminbi and dividends on H shares will be paid in Hong Kong dollars. The relevant exchange rate will be the average of the mid-point rates of Renminbi to Hong Kong dollars as announced by the People's Bank of China for the week prior to the date of declaration of dividends by the AGM (RMB 0.875334 equivalent to HK\$1.00).

Pursuant to the "Enterprise Income Tax Law of the People's Republic of China" and the "Regulations for the implementation of the Law of the People's Republic of China on Enterprise Income Tax", both implemented in 2008, the Company shall, pursuant to the legal requirements, withhold and pay 10% enterprise income tax when the Company distributes the 2009 final dividend to non-resident enterprise shareholders (including HKSCC Nominees Limited, corporate nominees or trustees, or other organizations or entities that are considered non-resident enterprise shareholders) whose names appear on the Company's H share register of members. For any natural person shareholders whose names appear on the Company's H share register of members, the Company will not withhold and pay enterprise income tax.

The Company has appointed ICBC (Asia) Trustee Company Limited as the receiving agent in Hong Kong (the "Receiving Agent") and will pay to such Receiving Agent the final dividend declared for payment to holders of H shares. The final dividend will be paid by the Receiving Agent net of the applicable tax on or about 30 July 2010. Relevant cheques will be dispatched on the same day to holders of H shares entitled to receive such dividend by ordinary post and at their own risk.
