**Gross generation of China Power in 2006
grew by approximately 19.47% over 2005
Net generation increased by approximately 19.05%**

China Power International Development Limited (the “Company” and stock code: 2380) announces today its gross generation and net generation for the year ended 31 December 2006.

According to the Company’s preliminary estimate, the consolidated gross generation of the power plants of the Company (excluding the power plant of its associated company) for the year ended 31 December 2006 amounted to 24,065,245 MWh, representing an increase of 19.47% over 2005. Consolidated net generation was 22,262,842 MWh, representing an increase of 19.05% compared with 2005.

The increase in the gross generation of the Company for 2006 was mainly attributable to (1) its installed capacity increased as a result of the acquisition of Shentou I Power Plant and technical upgrades in the first quarter of 2005; (2) the strong demand for electricity in regions where the power plants of the Company are located; (3) competitive advantages of power generation units were fully capitalized due to the strengthened management of the production and improved operating conditions of the power generation units.

The substantial decrease in the gross generation of the Company in the fourth quarter of 2006 compared with the same period of 2005 was mainly due to a major overhaul of the power generation units with total capacity of 1,200 MW of Pingwei Power Plant and Yaomeng Power Plant of the Company and Changshu Power Plant of the associated company. The demand for electricity in regions where the power plants of the Company are located is still strong in the fourth quarter of 2006.

The respective gross generation of the power plants of the Company and its associated company for the year ended 31 December 2006 and for the fourth quarter of 2006 were as follows:

The shares of the Company have been listed on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited since 15 October 2004. The Company is the flagship company of China Power Investment Corporation (one of the five national power generation groups in China) and its principal business is to develop, construct, manage and operate power plants in China.

The Company has 100% ownership in its three high-capacity coal-fired power plants under commercial operation, namely, Pingwei Power Plant, Yaomeng Power Plant and Shentou I Power Plant and 50% ownership in the associated company, Changshu Power Plant. The Company also owns a 25% stake in Shanghai Electric Power Co. Ltd., which is listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange. It has an attributable installed capacity of approximately 5,348 MW.
