China Power announces gross generation and total net generation in 2007

China Power International Development Limited (the "Company" and stock code: 2380) announces today its gross generation and net generation for the year ended 31 December 2007.

According to the Company's preliminary statistics, the consolidated gross generation of the power plants of the Company (excluding the power plant of its associated company) for the year ended 31 December 2007 amounted to 26,701,706 MWh, representing an increase of 10.96% compared with last year. The consolidated total net generation was 24,813,255 MWh, representing an increase of 11.46% compared with the same period of last year.

The increase in the gross generation of the Company for 2007 was mainly attributable to (1) the commencement of operation of unit No.3 and 4 of Pingwei Power Plant II and the unit No. 5 and 6 of Yaomeng Power Plant II; (2) improved reliability over operation for units of each power plant due to the strengthened management of the production.

The total net generation of the power plants of the Company and its associated company for the year ended 31 December 2007 was as follows:

The Company is the flagship company of China Power Investment Corporation (one of the five national power generation groups in China) and its principal business is to develop, construct, manage and operate power plants in China. The Company has 100% ownership in its five high-scale coal-fired power plants under commercial operation and 50% ownership in the associated company, Changshu Power Plant. The Company owned as controlling shareholder one high-scale coal-fired power plant which are under construction. The Company also owns a 21.92% stake in Shanghai Electric Power Co. Ltd., which is listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange. Currently, the Company has an attributable installed capacity of approximately 7,915 MW.
