GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE AND REPURCHASE SHARES, PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS AND NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

INTRODUCTION

The primary purposes of this circular are to provide you with information regarding the resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting and to give you notice of the Annual General Meeting.

Resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting, in addition to ordinary business, include (a) ordinary resolutions on the proposed grant of each of the General Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate and the Extension Mandate; and (b) ordinary resolutions relating to the proposed re-election of the Directors.

GRANT OF GENERAL MANDATE, REPURCHASE MANDATE AND EXTENSION MANDATE

The following mandates, which were granted to the Directors pursuant to the ordinary resolutions passed by the Shareholders at the annual general meeting of the Company held on 16 May 2008, will expire at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting:

- (A) a general unconditional mandate to allot, issue and deal with Shares with an aggregate nominal amount of not exceeding 20% of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution;
- (B) a general unconditional mandate to exercise all the powers of the Company to repurchase Shares with an aggregate nominal amount of not exceeding 10% of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution; and
- (C) the power to extend the general mandate mentioned in paragraph (A) immediately above by an amount representing the aggregate nominal amount of the Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the mandate to repurchase Shares as referred to in paragraph (B) immediately above.

In view of the forthcoming expiration of the mandates granted to the Directors as mentioned above, the following ordinary resolutions, among other matters, will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting:

- (1) that the Directors be granted the General Mandate to exercise the powers of the Company to allot, issue and otherwise deal with the Shares up to a maximum of 20% of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue as at the date of passing of such resolution;
- (2) that the Directors be granted the Repurchase Mandate to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase the Shares on the Stock Exchange or any other stock exchange on which the Shares may be listed and recognised by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange for such purpose up to a maximum of 10% of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue as at the date of passing of such resolution; and
- (3) that the Directors be granted the Extension Mandate to increase the total number of Shares which may be allotted, issued and dealt with under the General Mandate by an additional number representing such number of Shares repurchased under the Repurchase Mandate.

Each of the General Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate and the Extension Mandate will expire (a) at the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company following the Annual General Meeting; or (b) at the end of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Companies Law or the Articles to be held; or (c) when the authority given to the Directors thereunder is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in a general meeting prior to the next annual general meeting of the Company, whichever is the earliest.

Based on 2,612,500,000 Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date and on the bases that no new Shares will be issued and no Shares will be repurchased by the Company for the period from the Latest Practicable Date up to and including the date of the Annual General Meeting:

- (1) subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the General Mandate to the Directors, the Company will be allowed under the General Mandate to issue up to a maximum of 522,500,000 Shares, representing 20% of the Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date; and
- (2) subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase up to a maximum of 261,250,000 Shares, representing 10% of the Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date.

The Board has no immediate plans to allot and issue any new Shares other than Shares which may fall to be allotted and issued upon the exercise of any options granted under the share option scheme of the Company.

Under the Listing Rules, the Company is required to give the Shareholders all information which is reasonably necessary to enable them to make an informed decision as to whether to vote for or against the resolution in respect of the Repurchase Mandate at the Annual General Meeting. An explanatory statement for such purpose is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

CLOSURE OF REGISTER OF MEMBERS

In order to ascertain the entitlement to, among others, the final dividend for the year ended 31 December 2008, the register of members of the Company will be closed from 27 May 2009 (Wednesday) to 1 June 2009 (Monday) (both days inclusive) during which period no transfer of Shares may be effected.

Shareholders are reminded that in order to qualify for, among others, the final dividend for the year ended 31 December 2008, all transfers of Shares accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Branch Share Registrar for registration no later than 4:00 p.m. on 26 May 2009 (Tuesday).

PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to article 108A of the Articles, at least one-third of the Directors shall retire from office by rotation at each annual general meeting of the Company. Any Director who retires under this article shall then be eligible for re-election as Director. Mr. Yu Yingquan and Mr. Liu Xianggang, both being the executive Directors and Ms. Dong Yanfeng, being the independent non-executive Director, will retire as Directors and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election as Directors at the Annual General Meeting.

Biographical details of Mr. Yu Yingquan, Mr. Liu Xianggang and Ms. Dong Yanfeng are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN

Set out on pages 16 to 20 of this circular is a notice convening the Annual General Meeting at which resolutions will be proposed to approve, among other matters, the following:

- (a) the grant of the General Mandate, Repurchase Mandate and Extension Mandate; and
- (b) the proposed re-election of Directors.

Any vote of the Shareholders at the Annual General Meeting will be taken by poll.

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide the Shareholders with all the information reasonably necessary to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to approve the grant of the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors.

1. LISTING RULES RELATING TO THE REPURCHASE OF SHARES

The Listing Rules permit companies whose primary listings are on the Stock Exchange to repurchase their securities on the Stock Exchange and any other stock exchange on which securities of the company are listed and such exchange is recognised by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong subject to certain restrictions. Among such restrictions, the Listing Rules provide that the shares of such company must be fully paid up and all repurchases of shares by such company must be approved in advance by an ordinary resolution of shareholders, either by way of a general mandate or by specific approval of a particular transaction.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, there were a total of 2,612,500,000 Shares in issue.

Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate and on the bases that no new Shares are issued and no Shares are repurchased for the period from the Latest Practicable Date up to and including the date of the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase up to a maximum of 261,250,000 Shares, representing 10% of the issued share capital of the Company as at the Latest Practicable Date.

3. REASONS FOR THE REPURCHASES

The Directors believe that the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole to seek a general authority from the Shareholders to enable the Company to repurchase Shares on the Stock Exchange or any other stock exchange on which the Shares are listed. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such repurchases will benefit the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

4. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

Repurchases made pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate would be funded out of funds legally available for the purpose in accordance with the Company's memorandum of association, the Articles, the Companies Law, other applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and the Listing Rules. A listed company is prohibited from repurchasing its own securities on the Stock Exchange for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange from time to time. Under the Companies Law, repurchases by the Company may only be

made out of the profits of the Company or out of the proceeds of a fresh issue of Shares made for the purpose, or, if so authorised by the Articles and subject to the provisions of the Companies Law, out of capital. Any premium payable on a redemption or purchase over the par value of the Shares to be purchased must be provided for out of profits of the Company or out of the Company's share premium account, or, if so authorised by the Articles and subject to the provisions of the Companies Law, out of capital.

5. MATERIAL ADVERSE IMPACT IN THE EVENT OF REPURCHASE IN FULL

Taking into account the current working capital position of the Group, the Directors consider that, if the Repurchase Mandate were to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period, it might have a material adverse impact on the working capital and/or gearing position of the Company as compared with the position as at 31 December 2008, being the date of its latest published audited consolidated financial statements were made up. However, the Directors do not intend to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements or the gearing position of the Company which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

7. UNDERTAKING

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that they will exercise the power of the Company to make repurchases under the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and in accordance with the regulations set out in the memorandum of association of the Company and the Articles.

8. CONNECTED PERSON

None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their associates, have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company under the Repurchase Mandate if the same is approved by the Shareholders at the Annual General Meeting.

No connected person (as defined in the Listing Rules) of the Company has notified the Company that he/she/it has a present intention to sell Shares to the Company nor has any such connected person undertaken not to sell any Shares held by him/her/it to the Company, in the event that the grant of Repurchase Mandate to the Directors is approved by the Shareholders at the Annual General Meeting.

9. THE TAKEOVERS CODE AND MINIMUM PUBLIC HOLDING

If a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases on the Company exercising its powers to repurchase securities pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert (as defined in the Takeovers Code) could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, according to the register of interests kept by the Company pursuant to section 336 of the SFO and so far as is known to, or can be ascertained after reasonable enquiry by the Directors, the following persons were directly or indirectly interested in 5% or more of the issued Shares:

On the basis of 2,612,500,000 Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date and assuming there is no further issue or repurchase of Shares during the period from the Latest Practicable Date up to and including the date of the Annual General Meeting, if the Repurchase Mandate were exercised in full, the percentage shareholding of each of the above substantial Shareholders would increase to approximately 74.43% of the issued Shares respecting Merry Boom Group Limited and Mr. Tian Qixiang and to approximately 7.49% of the issued Shares respecting Victory Investment China Group Limited and Wang Rui Yun. Such increase would not give rise to an obligation on the part of any of the above substantial shareholders to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

Save as mentioned above, the Directors are currently not aware of any consequences which will arise under the Takeovers Code as a result of any purchase made under the Repurchase Mandate.

The Directors have no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent that would result in the number of Shares in the hands of public falling below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25%.

10. SHARE REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company had not purchased any of the Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) in the six months immediately preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

DETAILS OF THE DIRECTORS PROPOSED TO BE RE-ELECTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The following sets out the biographical details of the Directors eligible for re-election at the Annual General Meeting:

EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS

Mr. Yu Yingquan, aged 40, was appointed as an executive Director in March 2007. He is principally responsible for the overall management in investment and corporate finance of the Group. Mr. Yu first joined the Group as a director of Shangdong Shouguang Juneng Golden Corn Development Co., Ltd. (山東壽光巨能金玉米開發有限公司) ("Golden Corn") during the period from July 2003 to October 2005, and was re-appointed as director in 17 March 2007. Mr. Yu had worked in the accounting and internal audit departments of Shouguang Electricity Supply Company (壽光市供電公 司) since August 1990 holding positions as deputy supervisor of audit department, deputy supervisor and supervisor of finance department and deputy chief accountant. Mr. Yu took up the position as chief accountant of Shandong Shouguang Juneng Holding Group Co., Ltd. (山東壽光巨能控股集團 有限公司) ("Juneng Holding Group") upon its establishment to oversee the financial reporting and performance of all its investments. Mr. Yu is also a director of Juneng Holding Group since October 2005. Mr. Yu graduated from Shandong Hydro Institute (山東水利專科學校) in 1990 with a diploma in Hydro Economic and Financial Management (水利經濟與財務管理), and obtained a diploma in Finance Management (財務管理) from Shandong Economics Management Institute (山東省經濟管 理幹部學校院) in 1998. Mr. Yu obtained the Certificate of Accounting Professional of the People's Republic of China (中華人民共和國會計從業資格証書) issued by Finance Bureau of Shouguang City (壽光市財政局) in 1997.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Yu did not hold any position in the Group as at the Latest Practicable Date.

In the three years immediately preceding the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Yu has not been a director of any other publicly listed company.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr Yu was beneficially interested in approximately 0.4166% of the issued share capital of Merry Boom Group Limited, a substantial shareholder of the Company. Save as disclosed above, Mr. Yu was not related to any other Directors, senior management, substantial or controlling Shareholder of the Company and had no other interests in the Shares, underlying Shares and debenture of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO as at the Latest Practicable Date.

Mr. Yu has entered into a service contract with the Company for an initial term of three years with effect from 5 September 2007, which shall be renewed and extended automatically for successive terms of one year upon expiry of the then current term, unless terminated by either party by giving three month's written notice to the other.

DETAILS OF THE DIRECTORS PROPOSED TO BE RE-ELECTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Under the service contract, he is entitled to an annual salary of RMB300,000 (subject to an annual increment after 31 December 2008 at the discretion of the Directors of not more than 10% of the annual salary immediately prior to such increase). In addition, he is also entitled to a discretionary management bonus provided that the aggregate amount of bonuses payable to all the executive Directors for any financial year of the Company shall not exceed 5% of all the audited consolidated or combined net profit of the Group (after taxation and minority interests and payment of such bonuses but before extraordinary or exceptional items) in respect of that financial year of the Company.

There is no information which is discloseable nor is/was he involved in any matters required to be disclosed pursuant to any of the requirements of the provisions under the Rules 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules.

There are no other matters concerning Mr. Yu that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders.

Mr. Liu Xianggang, aged 40, was appointed as an executive Director in September 2007. He has been a director of Golden Corn since October 2005 principally responsible for the Group's production technology developments and cornstarch production. Mr. Liu has been an employee of Golden Corn since August 1998 holding positions as factory supervisor, technical department supervisor, deputy chief engineer, chief engineer, deputy general manager and factory manager. Mr. Liu had worked in the production technology department of Shouguang Electricity Supply Company from July 1990 to July 1997 as technical staff responsible for production management and production route design. Mr. Liu has also been the general manager and a director of Linqing Deneng Golden Corn Bio Limited (臨清德能金玉米生物有限公司) since 13 March 2008. Mr. Liu graduated from Shandong Industrial University (山東工業大學) in 1990 with an undergraduate degree in Industrial Management (工業管理工程), and obtained a post-graduate diploma in Industrial Economics (產業經濟學) from the Economics School of Shandong University (山東大學經濟學院) in 2003. Mr. Liu also obtained the qualification as senior engineer in December 2002. Mr. Liu is the deputy supervisor of the Cornstarch Professionals Committee (玉米澱粉專業委員會) of China Starch Industry Association (中國澱粉工業協會).

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Liu did not hold any position in the Group as at the Latest Practicable Date.

In the three years immediately preceding the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Liu has not been a director of any other publicly listed company.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr Liu was not related to any other Directors, senior management, substantial or controlling Shareholder of the Company and had no interests in the Shares, underlying Shares and debenture of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO.

DETAILS OF THE DIRECTORS PROPOSED TO BE RE-ELECTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Mr. Liu has entered into a service contract with the Company for an initial term of three years with effect from 5 September 2007, which shall be renewed and extended automatically for successive terms of one year upon expiry of the then current term, unless terminated by either party by giving three month's written notice to the other. Under the service contract, he is entitled to an annual salary of RMB252,000 (subject to an annual increment after 31 December 2008 at the discretion of the Directors of not more than 10% of the annual salary immediately prior to such increase).
