PROFIT WARNING

This announcement is made by China Merchants Land Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Listing Rules**”) and Inside Information Provisions (as defined under the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of the Company wishes to inform the shareholders of the Company and potential investors that, after the preliminary assessment by the Board of the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2020, which have not been reviewed by the Company’s auditors, it is expected that the net profit and the net profit attributable to the shareholders of the Company will decrease by approximately 69% and approximately 80% respectively, as compared to the corresponding period in 2019. Such decrease in profit is primarily due to the reasons as stated below:

- a) compared with the corresponding period in 2019, the significant decrease in the income from the associates and joint ventures of the Group carried forward for the six months ended 30 June 2020, and therefore a year-on-year decrease of the share of profits of associates and joint ventures under the equity method;
- b) compared with the corresponding period in 2019, a year-on-year increase in the interest expense due to the year-on-year increase of the average balances of borrowings of the Group; and

- c) the projects of joint ventures accounted for a higher percentage in the projects of the Group carried forward for the six months ended 30 June 2020 and therefore a decrease in the net profit attributable to the Company.

The Board considers the current fundamentals of the Company is healthy, as the unaudited aggregate contracted sales amount of the Group, together with its associates and joint ventures, recorded a year-on-year increase of approximately 24% for the six months ended 30 June 2020. The Company will continue to optimize its financial capital structure and improve its business operation level.

As the Company is still in the course of preparing the results for the six months ended 30 June 2020, the information contained in this announcement is only based on the preliminary assessment by the Board with reference to the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2020, which have not been reviewed by the auditors of the Company, and information currently available to the Board. The actual results of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2020 may be different from disclosures in this announcement. Further details on the financial results will be disclosed in due course pursuant to the requirements of the Listing Rules when the Group publishes its results for the six months ended 30 June 2020.

Shareholders of the Company and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
