NOTES

1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

14. Review of Performance

The Group recorded a revenue and profit before tax of RM130.5 million and RM3.1 million respectively for the 9 months ended 31 March 2010 as compared to RM53.8 million and RM7.9 million respectively in the preceding year's corresponding period.

The increase in revenue was mainly due to the higher revenue from the property development division as compared to the preceding year's corresponding period. Profit before tax was lower as against the preceding year's corresponding period due to the contribution of revaluation surplus from an associated company in that period.

15. Material changes in profit before taxation

The Group's loss before tax of RM6.1 million for the current quarter as compared to the immediate preceding quarter's profit before tax of RM0.4 million was mainly attributed to lower contribution from the property development activities.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group expects the performance for the current financial year to improve as compared to the previous financial year.
