## **POLL RESULTS OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 6 MAY 2022**

At the annual general meeting of Lapco Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) held on 6 May 2022 (the “**AGM**”), all the resolutions set out in the notice of AGM of the Company dated 30 March 2022 (the “**Notice of AGM**”) were duly passed by the shareholders of the Company (the “**Shareholders**”) by way of poll.

The board of directors (the “**Directors**”) of the Company is pleased to announce that all the proposed ordinary resolutions set out in the Notice of AGM (the “**Proposed Resolutions**”) were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll at the AGM held on Friday, 6 May 2022.

As at the date of the AGM, there were 400,000,000 issued shares of the Company (the “**Shares**”) entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM. There were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM as set out in Rule 17.47A of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the GEM of the Stock Exchange (the “**GEM Listing Rules**”).

None of the Shareholders was required under the GEM Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM. None of the Shareholders has stated in the Company’s circular dated 30 March 2022 (the “**Circular**”) his intention to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM.

The Company’s branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, was appointed and acted as the scrutineer for the purpose of vote-taking at the AGM.

Attendance record of the Directors at the AGM including the executive Directors, Mr. Cai Weiming, Mr. Wong Tsz Chun, Jacky and Mr. Tam Yiu Shing, Billy, and independent non-executive Directors, Mr. Mak Kwok Kei and Ms. Lam Kit Yan attended.
