To be valid, this form of proxy must be completed, signed and deposited at the Hong Kong share registrar of the Company, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited,17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, together with the power of attorney or any other authority under which it is signed (or a certified copy thereof), no later than 48 hours before the time for holding the meeting. The completion and return of the form of proxy shall not preclude members of the Company from attending and voting in person at the above AGM (or any adjourned meeting thereof).
