If more than one of such joint shareholders be present at the meeting personally or by proxy, the person whose name stands first in the Register of Members in respect of such share shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.

If a black rainstorm warning or a tropical cyclone warning signal number 8 or above is hoisted at 11:00 a.m. or any time after 11:00 a.m. or no 19 August 2022, the annual general meeting of the Company will not be held on that day but will be held at the same time and place on the first Business Day after 19 August 2022 instead.
