The Board gladly welcomes the announcement regarding to official commencement of the TD-CMMB service in China, which would signify that CMMB mobile TV will become a standard feature in China Mobile's 3G phones (TDS-CDMA).

The board (the "**Board**") of directors (the "**Director**(s)") of Global Flex Holdings Limited (the "**Company**") gladly welcomes the announcement of the TD-CMMB service commencement between China Mobile and China Broadcasting Corporation ("**CBC**"). TD-CMMB combines CMMB's mobile TV with China Mobile's 3G as a service package delivered to a TD-CMMB enabled handset users. The service commencement signifies that CMMB mobile TV will become a standard feature in China Mobile's 3G phones (TDS-CDMA).

On 22 March 2010, China Mobile together with CBC jointly announced that they will provide mobile users with TD-CMMB service. The TD-CMMB service commencement is a milestone for China's recently announced national policy for 3-Way Network Convergence, under which the CMMB platform converges mobile TV service with 3G communication and internet interactivity. The cooperation will likely propel CMMB development to new heights.

As announced previously, the Company has formally entered into CMMB related businesses and announced to change its name to "CMMB Vision." The Company will actively collaborate with key government bodies and industry leaders in China for the development and promotion of TD-CMMB.
