NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual General Meeting of Singamas Container Holdings Limited (the "Company") will be held at 24/F., Admiralty Centre 1, 18 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong on Friday, 23 June 2023 at 11:30 a.m. for the following purposes:

- 1. To receive and consider the audited financial statements and the reports of the directors and auditor of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2022.
- 2. To declare a final dividend for the year ended 31 December 2022.
- 3. To re-elect/elect the following retiring directors as directors of the Company:
 - (a) Ms. Siu Wai Yee, Winnie as executive director;
 - (b) Ms. Chung Pui King, Rebecca as executive director;
 - (c) Ms. Lau Man Yee, Vanessa as non-executive director; and
 - (d) Mr. Ho Teck Cheong as independent non-executive director.
- 4. To authorise the board of directors of the Company to fix the directors' remuneration.
- 5. To re-appoint Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu as the auditor of the Company for the ensuing year and to authorise the board of directors of the Company to fix their remuneration.
- 6. As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification the following resolution as an ordinary resolution of the Company:

"THAT:

(a) subject to paragraph (c) below, the exercise by the directors of the Company

("Directors") during the Relevant Period (as defined in paragraph (d) below) of all the powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with shares of the Company ("Shares"), to grant rights to subscribe for, or convert any security into, Shares (including the issue of any securities convertible into Shares, or options (including any options under any share option scheme adopted by the Company)), warrants or similar rights to subscribe for any Shares and to make or grant offers, agreements and options which might require the exercise of such power be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;

- (b) the approval in paragraph (a) above shall be in addition to any other authorisation given to the Directors and shall authorise the Directors during the Relevant Period to make or grant offers, agreements and options (including securities convertible into Shares, or option, warrants or similar rights to subscribe for any Shares) which might require the exercise of such power after the end of the Relevant Period:
- (c) the aggregate number of Shares allotted or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted and issued by the Directors pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) above, otherwise than pursuant to (i) a Rights Issue (as defined in paragraph (d) below), (ii) a grant of option or an issue of Shares under any share option scheme adopted by the Company or (iii) a dividend of the Company satisfied by the issue of Shares in accordance with the Articles of Association of the Company, shall not exceed 20% of the aggregate number of Shares in issue as at the date of the passing of this resolution (subject to adjustment in the case of any conversion of any or all of the Shares into a larger or smaller number of Shares) and the said approval shall be limited accordingly; and

(d) for the purposes of this resolution:

"Relevant Period" means the period from the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles of Association of the Company or any law applicable to be held; and
- (iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given under this resolution by an ordinary resolution of the members in general meeting of the Company.

"Rights Issue" means an offer of Shares or an offer or issue of warrants or options or similar instruments to subscribe for, or of securities convertible into, Shares open for a period fixed by the Directors to the holders of Shares (or, where appropriate, to holders of other securities of the Company entitled to the offer) or any class thereof and on the register on a fixed record date in proportion to their then holdings of Shares (or, where appropriate, such other securities) or class thereof (subject to such exclusion or other arrangements as the Directors may deem necessary or expedient in relation to fractional entitlements or having regard to any restriction or obligation under the laws of, or the requirements of,

any recognised regulatory body or any stock exchange in any territory applicable to the Company)."

7. As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification the following resolution as an ordinary resolution of the Company:

"THAT:

- (a) subject to paragraph (b) below, the exercise by the directors of the Company ("Directors") during the Relevant Period (as defined in paragraph (c) below) of all the powers of the Company to repurchase its issued shares of the Company ("Shares") on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited ("Stock Exchange") or any other stock exchange on which the Shares may be listed and recognised by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange for this purpose subject to and in accordance with all applicable laws and/or the requirements of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the Stock Exchange or of any other stock exchange as amended from time to time, be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the aggregate number of Shares to be repurchased or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be repurchased by the Directors pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) above during the Relevant Period shall not exceed 10% of the aggregate number of Shares in issue as at the date of the passing of this resolution (subject to adjustment in the case of any conversion of any or all of the Shares into a larger or smaller number of Shares) and the said approval be limited accordingly; and
- (c) for the purposes of this resolution:

"Relevant Period" means the period from the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles of Association of the Company or any law applicable to be held; and
- (iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given under this resolution by an ordinary resolution of the members in general meeting of the Company."
- 8. As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification the following resolution as an ordinary resolution of the Company:

"THAT:

conditional on the passing of resolutions numbered 6 and 7 as set out in the notice of the meeting of which this resolution forms part, the aggregate number of shares of the Company repurchased by the directors of the Company ("Directors") under the authority granted to the Directors mentioned in such resolution numbered 7 shall be added to the aggregate number of shares of the Company ("Shares") that may be

allotted or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted by the Directors pursuant to resolution numbered 6 above, provided that the amount of Shares repurchased by the Directors shall not exceed 10% of the total number of Shares in issue on the date of this resolution (subject to adjustment in the case of any conversion of any or all of the Shares into a larger or smaller number of Shares)."

9. As a special business, to consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification the following resolution as a special resolution of the Company:

"THAT:

- (a) the Articles of Association of the Company be and is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (i) by deleting article numbered 50 of the Articles of Association of the Company in its entirety and substituting it with the following:
 - "50. Subject to the provisions of the Ordinance and the Listing Rules, an annual general meeting shall be called by at least twenty-one clear days' notice, and a meeting of the company other than an annual general meeting or a meeting for the passing of a special resolution shall be called by at least fourteen clear days' notice. The notice shall specify the place of the meeting (and if the meeting is to be held in two or more places, the principal place of the meeting and other place or places of the meeting), the date and the time of the meeting, the general nature of such business, comply with section 576 of the Ordinance and contain a statement specifying a member's right to appoint a proxy under section 596(1) and (3) of the Ordinance, and in the case of an annual general meeting shall specify the meeting as such. Subject to the provisions of these articles, notices shall be given to all members, to all persons entitled to a share in consequence of the death or bankruptcy of a member and to the directors and auditors of the Company.";
 - (ii) by deleting article numbered 70 of the Articles of Association of the Company in its entirety and substituting it with the following:
 - "70. No member shall have the right to speak or to vote at any general meeting or at any separate meeting of the holders of any class of shares, either in person or by representative or proxy, in respect of any share held by him unless all amounts presently payable by him in respect of that share have been paid.";
 - (iii) by deleting article numbered 78A of the Articles of Association of the Company in its entirety and substituting it with the following:
 - "78A. If a recognised clearing house (or its nominee) within the meaning of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong), as from time to time supplemented, amended or substituted, or a clearing house recognised by the laws of any other jurisdiction

in which the shares of the Company are listed or quoted with the permission of the Company on a stock exchange in such jurisdiction, is a member of the Company it may, by resolution of its directors or other governing body or by power of attorney, authorise such person or persons as it thinks fit to act as its representative or representatives at any meeting of the Company or at any meeting of any class of members of the Company provided that, if more than one person is so authorised, the authorization shall specify the number and class of shares in respect of which each such person is so authorised. A person so authorised pursuant to this provision shall be entitled to exercise the same powers on behalf of the recognized clearing house (or its nominee) which he represents as that clearing house (or its nominee) could exercise if it were an individual member of the Company including the right to speak and to vote."; and

- (iv) by deleting article numbered 98 of the Articles of Association of the Company in its entirety and substituting it with the following:
 - "98. Subject as aforesaid, the directors may appoint a person who is willing to act to be a director, either to fill a casual vacancy or as an additional director, and who shall hold office only until the first annual general meeting of the Company after his appointment, and shall then be eligible for re-election, provided that the appointment does not cause the number of directors to exceed any number fixed as the maximum number of directors."; and
- (b) the Articles of Association, a copy of which has been produced to the meeting marked "A" and initialled by the Chairman of the meeting for the purpose of identification, be and are hereby approved and adopted as the Articles of Association of the Company in substitution for, and to the exclusion of, the existing Articles of Association of the Company with effect from the conclusion of this meeting and THAT any Director or the Company Secretary of the Company be and is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to effect and record the amendments to the Articles of Association of the Company."
