THINK GREEN INITIATIVE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD GRANTED TO TTI

(Hong Kong, July 12, 2010) – **Techtronic Industries Co. Ltd.** ("TTI or the "Group" (HKEX Stock Code: 669, ADR symbol: TTNDY) has become the first Global Manufacturer to be awarded the Think Green Initiative (TGI) Achievement Award.

The TGI program is a tool used to assist organizations with the assessment, monitoring, implementation and global benchmarking of their environmental performance. Such visibility with measured results helps facilitate continuous improvement. As companies improve their score and comparative industry benchmark performance, they migrate from Thinking Green to Acting Green and Becoming Green.

By implementing the TGI program, TTI has focused on a disciplined process to continuously improve its environmental performance, while benefiting from cost savings and demonstrating a reduction in its carbon footprint, thereby becoming a more environmentally-friendly company.

Intertek, a UK listed company that provides testing, inspection and assessment services in more than 110 countries, has developed the TGI program together with major global retailers and brands looking to improve the environmental performance of their supply chains. The program was officially launched in 2009 with participating retailers and brands. The Home Depot[®] (THD) was the first major participant and sponsor of the program. So far, 60 TGI participating factories have joined the program in China, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Thailand and the Philippines.

TGI is basically an assessment tool consisting of eight modules:

- Two core compliance modules
 - o Environmental legal compliance review
 - o Environmental management system
- Six environmental modules
 - o Water
 - o Air emission
 - o Energy
 - Noise emission
 - Hazardous material, equipment and waste
 - o Sustainable production

Led and coordinated by the Quality System Assurance team, a TGI training and audit program commenced at TTI's Asia Industrial Park at Dongguan in December 2009. TTI has worked towards achieving a High score performance of 85 against a global average of 54 which qualifies it for an "Achievement Award" for good performance. Mr. Zamudio, the head of THD's Global Sourcing Social and Environmental Responsibility Department, was very proud of the program and spoke highly of TTI's achievement. THD values TTI's unique position as a large and reliable manufacturer, and is very impressed and proud of TTI's environmentally-friendly manufacturing process. THD appreciates suppliers who take "green" initiatives to continuously shrink the carbon footprint and cut costs.
