PROPOSALS FOR GENERAL MANDATES TO REPURCHASE SHARES AND ISSUE NEW SHARES, RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS AND NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the resolutions to be proposed at the AGM to be held on 8 September 2009. These include, among other things, i) ordinary resolutions relating to the granting to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate and the Issue Mandate; and ii) ordinary resolutions relating to the re-election of each of the retiring Directors.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed that the Directors be granted the Repurchase Mandate to exercise all powers of the Company to repurchase on the Stock Exchange, or on any other stock exchange on which the Shares of the Company may be listed, Shares up to a maximum of 10 per cent of the issued share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution.

An explanatory statement required by the Listing Rules to be sent to the Shareholders in connection with the Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix I to this circular. The explanatory statement contains all information reasonably necessary to enable the Shareholders to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the relevant resolution at the AGM.

THE ISSUE MANDATE

An ordinary resolution will also be proposed at the AGM that the Directors be granted the Issue Mandate to issue, allot and deal with Shares up to a maximum of 20 per cent of the issued share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, there was a total of 1,844,886,976 Shares in issue. Subject to the passing of the resolution granting the Issue Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased before the AGM, the Company will be allowed to issue a maximum of 368,977,395 Shares.

In addition, an ordinary resolution will further be proposed at the AGM adding any Shares repurchased under the Repurchase Mandate to the Issue Mandate. APPENDIX I

This Appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide certain information to you for your consideration of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, there was a total of 1,844,886,976 Shares in issue.

Subject to the passing of the resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased before the AGM, the Company will be allowed to repurchase a maximum of 184,488,697 Shares, being 10 per cent of the issued share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution for granting the Repurchase Mandate.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders to seek a general authority from the Shareholders to enable the Company to repurchase its Shares on the Stock Exchange. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value and/or earnings per share of the Company and will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

Repurchases made pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate would be funded out of funds legally available for the purpose in accordance with the Company's memorandum and articles of association and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited accounts contained in the Annual Report for the year ended 31 March 2009) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate were to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. 5. GENERAL

None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their associates, has any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company, if the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

Accordingly, a Shareholder, or a group of Shareholders acting in concert, depending on the level of increase of the Shareholders' interest, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, to the best of the knowledge and belief of the Company, Silver Crown Profits Limited ("Silver Crown") and Ms. Lam Yuk Sum ("Ms. Lam"), director, held 1,134,601,359 and 170,963,476 shares representing 61.50 per cent and 9.27 per cent respectively of the issued share capital of the Company. In the event that the Directors exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares which is proposed to be granted pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, the respective shareholding of Silver Crown and Ms. Lam in the Company would be increased to approximately 68.33 per cent and 10.30 per cent of the issued share capital of the Company. Such increase would not give rise to an obligation to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code but would reduce the percentage of Shares held by the public to less than 25 per cent. The Directors have no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as may result in the public shareholding being reduced to below the minimum public float requirement.

No Shares had been repurchased by the Company, whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise, in the last six months preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

1. MS. LAM YUK SUM ("MS. LAM")

Ms. Lam, aged 49, joined the Group in 1987 and was appointed as an Executive Director of the Company on 25 February 1999 and the Chief Executive Officer on 31 August 2005. She is responsible for the overall strategic planning as well as the Group's merchandising management and design and product development. Ms. Lam has more than 20 years of experience in fashion design and garment industry.

Ms. Lam has entered into a service agreement with the Company for a term of three years, which is determinable by three months' written notice. She is also subject to retirement and re-election provisions at annual general meetings of the Company in accordance with the Articles. For the year ended 31 March 2009, Ms. Lam received total emoluments of HK\$672,000 from the Group. The emoluments of Ms. Lam are determined by the Board and its Remuneration Committee with reference to her duties and responsibilities and the market rates for the position.

Apart from being an Executive Director, the Chief Executive Officer and a director of the subsidiaries of the Company namely Veeko Fashion Company Limited, Veeko Trading Fashion Company Limited, Dong Guan Dico Fashion Co., Ltd. (in Dissolution), Wina Success Limited, Veeko Holdings Limited, Veeko Advertising Agency Company Limited, Veeko Fashion Overseas Company Limited, Veeko Fashion Far East Company Limited, I-mix Fashion Company Limited, 汕頭華南迪高時裝有限公司, Veeko Trading (Macao Commercial Offshore) Limited, Win Ahead Investments Limited, Meko Fashion (Zhuhai-Macau Cross Boarder Industrial Zone, Zhuhai) Company Limited, Shantou Yungao Fashion Company Limited, Colourmix Holdings Limited, Colourmix Cosmetics Company Limited, Colourmix International Holdings Limited, Beauty Mix Company Limited, Colourmix Cosmetics Retail Company Limited, and Colourmix Trading (Macao Commercial Offshore) Limited, Ms. Lam does not hold any other major position with the Company or any of its subsidiaries. 2. MR. CHENG CHUNG HOO ("MR. CHENG")

Mr. Cheng, aged 72, was appointed as an Independent Non-Executive Director of the Company with effect from 23 March 1999 and he is also the chairman of both the Remuneration Committee and the Audit Committee.

Mr. Cheng has been a managing director of an international trading and property development company since 1975 and also a managing director of a property investment company for over 17 years. Mr. Cheng does not hold any directorships in other public companies, the securities of which are listed in Hong Kong or overseas, in the last three years.
