This is an explanatory statement given to all Members relating to a resolution to be proposed at the AGM authorising the Repurchase Mandate.

This explanatory statement contains information required pursuant to Rule 13.08 of the GEM Listing Rules which are set out as follows:

1 EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 614,435,000 Shares.

Subject to the passing of resolution 2(b) as set out in the Notice and on the assumptions that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 61,443,500 Shares, representing 10% of the issued share capital as at the Latest Practicable Date.

2 REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and the Members as a whole for the Directors to have a general authority from Members to enable the Company to repurchase Shares in the market. Such repurchases may, depending on the market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net value of the Company and its assets and/or its earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such repurchases will benefit the Company and Members as a whole.

3 FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited financial statements of the Company for the year ended 31st December 2018) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

The Directors have no present intention to repurchase Shares to such an extent as would result in takeover obligations or the number of Shares in the hands of public falling below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25%.

FUNG KEE YUE ROGER

FUNG Kee Yue Roger, aged 66, was first appointed as an independent non-executive Director on 30th September 2004. He was the managing director of Mitel Networks Asia Pacific Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Mitel Networks Corporation in Canada. Prior to Mitel, he was the President of Newbridge Networks Asia Pacific Limited, He graduated from the University of Toronto, Canada with a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in industrial engineering. He was a member of Professional Engineers Ontario, Canada. He has more than thirty years of experience in the telecommunications and electronics industry. He did not hold any directorships in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years and he is not related to any Director, senior management of the Company, persons who are entitled to exercise, or control the exercise of, 10% or more of the voting power at any general meeting of the Company and Controlling Shareholders.
