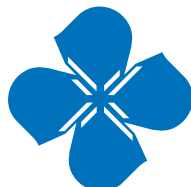

**POLL RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 27 MAY 2011
AND RETIREMENT OF A NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**

The Board is pleased to announce that all the resolutions set out in the notice of the Annual General Meeting dated 21 April 2011 were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll at the Annual General Meeting held on 27 May 2011.

The Board also announces that Mr. Zhou Mingchen retired by rotation as a non-executive Director of the Company at the Annual General Meeting held on 27 May 2011 and ceased to be the chairman and a member of the Nomination Committee of the Company on the same date.

Reference is made to the circular of Xingda International Holdings Limited (“**Company**”) dated 21 April 2011 (“**Circular**”) in relation to, among other matters, proposals for general mandates to issue and repurchase Shares and re-election of Directors. Terms used in this announcement shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular unless defined otherwise herein.

The Board is pleased to announce that all the resolutions (“**Resolutions**”) set out in the notice of the Annual General Meeting dated 21 April 2011 (“**AGM Notice**”) were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll at the Annual General Meeting held on 27 May 2011.

The Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, was appointed as the scrutineer for the vote-taking at the Annual General Meeting.

The total number of Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the Resolutions at the Annual General Meeting was 1,524,776,693 Shares, representing the entire issued share capital of the Company as at the date of the Annual General Meeting. There were no restrictions on any Shareholders to cast votes on any of the Resolutions proposed at the Annual General Meeting and there were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote only against the Resolutions at the Annual General Meeting.

The Board also announces that Mr. Zhou Mingchen (“**Mr. Zhou**”) retired by rotation as a non-executive Director of the Company at the Annual General Meeting held on 27 May 2011 pursuant to Article 87 of the Company’s Articles of Association and did not offer himself for re-election since Mr. Zhou decided to re-allocate his time for his other business. Immediately following Mr. Zhou’s retirement, he ceased to be the chairman and a member of the Nomination Committee of the Company.

Mr. Zhou has confirmed that he has no disagreement with the Board and is not aware of any matter in connection with his retirement that needs to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders.

The Board would like to extend its gratitude to Mr. Zhou for his invaluable efforts and contributions to the Company during his term of appointment and offers its best wishes to him.
