The Additional Notes will be consolidated and form a single series with the Original Notes upon issue.

RATING OF THE ADDITIONAL NOTES

The Original Notes were assigned a rating of "Baa3" by Moody's. The Additional Notes are expected to have the same rating of "Baa3" assigned and/or confirmed by Moody's.

PRINCIPAL TERMS OF THE ADDITIONAL NOTES

Additional Notes Offered

The Additional Notes will comprise CNY700,000,000 4.00% guaranteed notes to be subscribed, or procured to be subscribed, severally and not jointly by the Joint Lead Managers, which will mature in 2026. The Additional Notes will be consolidated and form a single series with the Original Notes upon issue.

Issue Price

The Additional Notes shall be issued at a price equal to 99.995% of the principal amount of the Additional Notes plus accrued interest from (and including) 15 November 2023 to (but excluding) the Issue Date.

Interest Rate

The Additional Notes will bear interest on their outstanding principal amount from and including 15 November 2023 at the rate of 4.00% per annum, payable semi-annually in arrear on the Interest Payment Date (as defined in the Terms and Conditions) falling on, or nearest to, 15 May and 15 November in each year.

Ranking of the Additional Notes and Guarantee

The Additional Notes will constitute direct, unsubordinated, unconditional, and (subject to the negative pledge covenant set out in the Terms and Conditions) unsecured obligations of the Issuer and shall at all times rank *pari passu* and without any preference among themselves. The payment obligations of the Issuer under the Additional Notes and of the Company under the guarantee given by the Company under the Trust Deed shall, save for such exceptions as may be provided by applicable legislation and subject to the negative pledge covenant set out in the Terms and Conditions, at all times rank at least equally with all other unsecured and unsubordinated indebtedness and monetary obligations of the Issuer and the Company, respectively, present and future.

Redemption Right

The Noteholders are entitled to redemption right pursuant to the Change of Control Put Option (as defined below) under the Terms and Conditions.

If, at any time while any of the Notes remains outstanding, a Change of Control Put Event (as defined in the Terms and Conditions) occurs, then the holder of each such Note will have the option (a "**Change of Control Put Option**"), subject to certain conditions, to require the Issuer to redeem or otherwise purchase that Note at the price set out in the Terms and Conditions.

A "**Change of Control Put Event**" includes, among others, the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the Guangzhou Municipal People's Government, GZYX or their respective successors ceasing to have, either directly or indirectly or as the beneficiary of a trust, acting individually or together, Control of the Company.

Accordingly, the condition described above imposes an obligation on GZYX to maintain Control of the Company, which constitutes a specific performance obligation on a controlling shareholder under Rule 13.18 of the Listing Rules, the breach of which would cause a default under the Terms and Conditions whereby the Noteholders are entitled to exercise their Change of Control Put Options. The aggregate amount of the Notes that may be affected if the Noteholders exercise their Change of Control Put Options is CNY1,210,000,000, being the aggregate principal amount of the Original Notes and the Additional Notes. The life of the facility for the purpose of Rule 13.18 of the Listing Rules is a period of three years from 15 November 2023 to the Interest Payment Date (as defined in the Terms and Conditions) falling on, or nearest to, 15 November 2026 in respect of the Notes.

LISTING

The Original Notes are listed on the MOX effective from 16 November 2023. The Issuer will apply for the listing of the Additional Notes on the MOX by way of debt issues to professional investors (as defined in Section 11 of the Guideline on Provision and Distribution of Financial Products (Circular no. 033/B/2010-DSB/AMCM dated 17 September 2010), Section 2.7 of the Guideline on Underwriting and Trustee Business of Corporate Bond (Circular no. 011/B/2023-DSB/AMCM dated 1 November 2023) and Section 2.7 of the Guideline on Issuance and Information Disclosure of Corporate Bond (Circular no. 011/B/2023-DSB/AMCM dated 1 November 2023)) only.

Company Limited (whether on a standalone or aggregated basis) contemplated under the Subscription Agreement will be regarded as *de minimis* connected transactions and are fully exempt from announcement, reporting and independent Shareholders' approval requirements under Chapter 14A of the Listing Rules.
